## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to allow the donation of certain items INCLUDING BICYCLES SEIZED AND FORFEITED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-5-101(d), regarding the disposition of seized property, is amended to read as follows:
(d)(1)(A) Unclaimed Except as provided in subdivision (d)(2) of this section, unclaimed seized property shall be sold at public auction to be held by the chief law enforcement officer of the county, city, or town law enforcement agency that seized the unclaimed seized property or the chief law enforcement officer's designee.
(2)(B) The proceeds of the sale, less the cost of the sale and any storage charge incurred in preserving the unclaimed seized property, shall be paid into the general fund of the county, city, or town whose law enforcement agency performed the seizure.
(2)(A) Unclaimed seized property that is a recreational item may be donated at no cost to a local or state agency, a nonprofit organization, or an educational program designed to provide education, assistance, or recreation to children.
(B) As used in subdivision (d)(2) (A) of this section
