#### Abstract

CONCERNING THE POSTING OF WARNING SIGNS RELATING TO DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES dURING PREGNANCY.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 3, Chapter 9, Subchapter lis amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

3-9-102. Posting of warning signs relating to drinking alcoholic beverages during pregnancy.
(a) A person who has received a permit under any law of this state for the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages, beer, or wine for on-premises consumption shall post in a conspicuous place a printed sign at least eleven inches by fourteen inches (11"x14") with letters at least one inch (1") high that reads "Warning: Drinking alcoholic beverages during pregnancy can cause birth defects".
(b) The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall make a sign meeting the requirements of this section available to a person who has received a permit under any law of this state for the sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverages, beer, or wine for on-premises consumption.
(c) The board shall promulgate rules to implement this section.
(d) A person who knowingly fails or refuses to post the sign required
by this section is guilty of a violation and shall be fined in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars ( $\$ 100$ ) for each violation of this section.
