18 19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-24-201(b), concerning the membership of	
21	the State Board of Collection Agencies, is amended to read as follows:	
22	(b)(1)(A)(i) One (1) member shall be selected by the Governor from a	
23	list of three (3) names furnished to him or her by the Associated Credit	
24	Bureaus of Arkansas and another shall be selected from a list of three (3)	
25	names submitted by the Arkansas members of the American Collectors	
26	Association.	
27	(ii) The persons whose names are submitted to the	
28	Governor by the Associated Credit Bureaus of Arkansas and the Arkansas	
29	members of the American Collectors Association shall all be actively engaged	
30	as the owners or managers of a collection agency or someone employed by	
31	collection agencies in an executive capacity.	
32	(B) All nominees on the list submitted to the Governor	
33	shall be individuals who have been actively engaged in connection with the	
34	operation of a collection agency for five (5) years next preceding their	
35	appointment.	
36	(2) One (1) member, who shall not be a member of either such	

1	association, shall be selected from the public at large.
2	(3)(A) One (1) member shall represent the elderly and shall be
3	sixty (60) years of age or older.
4	(B) This member shall not be actively engaged in or
5	retired from the operation of a collection agency.
6	(C) He or she shall be selected from the state at large
7	subject to confirmation by the Senate and shall be a full voting member but
8	shall not participate in the grading of examinations.
9	(4) (A) One (1) member shall be selected to represent the check-
10	cashing industry an employee of a credit counseling agency that is exempt
11	from taxation under § 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as existing on
12	January 1, 2011.
13	(B) He or she shall be an Arkansas resident who is
14	actively engaged as the owner or manager of a check-cashing operation
15	licensed to do business in the State of Arkansas.
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17	SECTION 2. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE DO NOT CODIFY. (a) This act shall
18	be construed to shorten the term of the member of the State Board of
19	Collection Agencies selected to represent the check-cashing industry.
20	(b) As of the effective date of this act, the member of the board
21	selected to represent the check-cashing industry shall cease to be a member
22	of the board.
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
