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SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that public school teachers should continue to receive pay at a level that will enable the state to maintain a constitutionally sound system of education; that it is necessary to revise the public laws on teacher salaries; and that this act is immediately

1	necessary to ensure the new teacher salary schedule is in place for the 2011-
2	2012 school year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act
3	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,
4	and safety shall become effective on:
5	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
6	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
7	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
8	<pre>bill; or</pre>
9	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
10	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
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
