## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REVISE THE UNIFORM REAL PROPERTY ELECTRONIC RECORDING ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REGULATE THE ELECTRONIC RECORDING LAW.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-2-305(a), concerning the composition of the Electronic Recording Commission, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

14-2-305. Administration and standards.
(a) (1) An Electronic Recording Commission consisting of nine (9) eleven (ll) members appointed by the Governor is created to adopt standards to implement this subchapter.
(2) A majority of the members of the commission must be county recorders.
(3) A member of the commission must be an active state legislator.
(3)(4) A member of the commission shall serve a term of two (2) years.
(4)(5) The terms of the current commission members on July 31, 2009 shall expire on September 1, 2009.
(5)(6) Each member of the commission may receive expense reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-2-305, concerning assigning the Bureau
of Legislative Research to assist in administering the Uniform Real Property

Electronic Recording Act, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(c) A staff member of the Bureau of Legislative Research will be assigned to assist the Electronic Recording Commission. The staff member will coordinate meetings, accumulate information, and provide general support to the commission.
