8 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER
9 EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH A FORMULA FOR DETERMINING
10 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNTS UNDER THE ARKANSAS ACADEMIC
11 CHALLENGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM -- PART 2; AND FOR
12 OTHER PURPOSES.

15 ARKANSAS ACADEMIC CHALLENGE SCHOLARSHIP
16 REVENUE STABILIZATION ACT.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-85-212(e)(1), concerning scholarship*
23 *awards for the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 2, is*
24 *amended to read as follows:*

25 *(e)(1)(A) The scholarship award amount under this subchapter for an*
26 *academic year for a full-time recipient enrolled in a four-year approved*
27 *institution of higher education ~~is five thousand dollars (\$5,000)~~ shall be*
28 *calculated by the Department of Higher Education using the formula under § 6-*
29 *85-221.*

30 *~~(B)(i) The Department of Higher Education shall award an~~*
31 *~~aggregate amount of scholarship awards to current achiever students beginning~~*
32 *~~with the 2010-2011 academic year of up to forty one million five hundred~~*
33 *~~thousand dollars (\$41,500,000).~~*

34 *~~(ii) The department shall not accept new~~*
35 *~~applications from current achiever students for scholarships ~~under this~~~~*
36 *~~subdivision (e)(1)(B) after June 1, 2012.~~*



1 ~~(C) After deducting the amount committed for current~~
2 ~~achiever student scholarships from the amount available under subdivision~~
3 ~~(e)(1)(B) of this section, the department shall use the balance to fund~~
4 ~~scholarships to nontraditional students under this subchapter.~~

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6 SECTION 2. Arkansas Title 6, Chapter 85, Subchapter 2, is amended to
7 add an additional section to read as follows:

8 6-85-221. Formula for determining scholarship award amounts.

9 (a) Annually by May 31, the Department of Higher Education shall
10 determine the scholarship award amount for full-time scholarship recipients
11 attending a four-year approved institution of higher education under this
12 subchapter calculated using the assumptions and formula under this section.

13 (b)(1) The Department of Higher Education shall use the following
14 method to project the number of eligible traditional student applicants:

15 (A) The Department of Higher Education shall obtain from
16 the Department of Education the number of high school students who are
17 anticipated to graduate high school with the requirements of § 6-85-207;

18 (B) The projected number of traditional students under
19 subdivision (b)(1)(A) shall be multiplied by the percentage of traditional
20 students who received the scholarship in the previous academic year and
21 attended a four-year approved institution of higher education;

22 (C) The projected number of traditional students under
23 subdivision (b)(1)(A) shall be multiplied by the percentage of traditional
24 students who received the scholarship in the previous academic year and
25 attended a two-year approved institution of higher education.

26 (D) The number of nursing students shall be projected as
27 the same number receiving a scholarship under this subchapter for the
28 previous year.

29 (E) The sum of the number of students under subdivisions
30 (b)(1)(B) - (D) of this section shall be increased by an annual growth factor
31 of one percent (1%).

32 (F) A dropout rate shall be applied to the number of
33 students under subdivision (b)(1)(E) of this section as follows:

34 (i) Thirty-five percent (35%) of students who
35 received the scholarship for the previous academic year;

36 (ii) Ten percent (10%) of students who have received

1 the scholarship for two (2) previous years; and

2 (iii) Ten percent (10%) of students have received
3 the scholarship for the previous three (3) academic years.

4 (2) The number of current achiever students shall be projected
5 at the number of current achiever students receiving the scholarship for the
6 previous academic year, less those who are no longer eligible for the
7 scholarship.

8 (3) The number of nontraditional students is not calculated as
9 long as the aggregate award amount is an amount set by statute.

10 (5) The number of students receiving a scholarship award under
11 the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 1, § 6-85-101 et
12 seq., shall be projected at the number of current recipients for the previous
13 academic year, less those who are no longer eligible for the scholarship.

14 (c) The Department of Higher Education shall calculate the amount of
15 funding available for scholarship awards for one (1) academic year as:

16 (1) The sum of net proceeds from the lottery for the twelve (12)
17 months beginning May 1 of the immediately preceding calendar year through
18 April 30 of the current calendar year;

19 (2) The amount of any balance of net proceeds from the lottery
20 carried forward from the previous year; plus

21 (3) The amount of nonlottery educational resources allocated to
22 the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Parts 1 and 2.

23 (d) The scholarship award amount for a traditional student attending a
24 four-year approved institution of higher education shall be an amount equal
25 to:

26 (A) The sum of:

27 (i) The total amount of available funding calculated
28 under subsection (c) of this section; less

29 (ii) The amount of funding under § 6-85-212 for
30 nontraditional students; less

31 (iii) The amount of scholarship awards under the
32 Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 1 multiplied by the
33 number of projected recipients calculated under subdivision (b)(4) of this
34 section; less

35 (iv) The amount of twenty million dollars
36 (\$20,000,000) to be maintained as a balance; divided by

1 (B) The total number of students calculated under
2 subdivisions (b)(1)-(3) of this section.

3 (e)(1) The Department of Higher Education may annually adjust the
4 assumptions for annual growth rate under subdivision (b)(1)(D) of this
5 section and dropout rate under subdivision (b)(1)(E) of this section based on
6 actual updated data.

7 (2) The Department of Higher Education shall provide a thirty-
8 day notice to the Arkansas Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee
9 before making any adjustments to the dropout rate or other assumptions under
10 this formula.

11 (3) Annually by May 1, the Department of Higher Education shall
12 provide to the committee all of the underlying assumptions the Department of
13 Higher Education will use to make the calculations under this section.

14 (f)(1) Annually by June 1, the Department of Higher Education shall:

15 (A) Publish a notice of the scholarship award amount on
16 its website in a manner easily accessible to the public; and

17 (B) Provide notice to the committee of the scholarship
18 award amount and a detailed calculation of the anticipated scholarship award
19 amounts for:

20 (i) Traditional students, current achiever students,
21 nontraditional students, and nursing students receiving scholarships under
22 the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 2; and

23 (ii) Students receiving scholarships under the
24 Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship Program - Part 1.

25 (2) Annually by October 31 and March 31, the Department of
26 Higher Education shall provide a written report to the committee on the
27 aggregate scholarship awards to each institution of higher education for the
28 applicable term.
