4	§ 2. Qualifications and appointment of members — Terms of office of		
5	first commission.		
6	Within ten days after the convening of the General Assembly of the		
7	State of Arkansas in the year 1953, the Governor, by and with the advice and		
8	consent of the Senate, shall appoint five persons who are qualified electors		
9	of the State to constitute the State Highway Commission for terms of two,		
10	four, six, eight and ten years respectively. The terms of the persons so		
11	appointed shall be determined by lot. The Commissioners to be appointed from		
12	the State at large; provided, however, that <del>no two Commissioners shall be</del>		
13	appointed from any single Congressional District at least one member shall be		
14	appointed from each Congressional District.		
15	In the event of rejection by the Senate of a person whose name has been		
16	so submitted, the Governor shall within five days after receipt of written		
17	notice from the Secretary of the Senate of such rejection submit the name of		
18	another appointee to fill such vacancy. In the event the Governor should		
19	within five days thereafter fail to appoint or fail to submit to the Senate		
20	for confirmation the name of any person to be appointed, the Senate shall
