2 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE — CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 8-6-3 607 is amended to read as follows:

4 8-6-607. Collection of fees.

Fees imposed pursuant to under the separate provisions of this subchapter shall be collected as follows:

- (1) Each landfill permittee and each transporter shall submit to the department on or before January 15, April 15, July 15, and October 15 of each year a quarterly report which that accurately states the total weight or volume of solid waste received at the landfill or transported out of state during the quarter just completed;
- (2) On or before January 15, April 15, July 15, and October 15 of each year, each landfill permittee and solid waste transporter shall pay to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality the full amount of such disposal fees due for the quarter just completed;
- (3) Except as provided in subdivision (4) subdivisions (4) and

  (5) of this section, the disposal and transportation fees collected pursuant

  to under this section shall be special revenues and shall be deposited in the

  State Treasury to the credit of the Solid Waste Management and Recycling Fund

  for administrative support of the State Marketing Board for Recyclables; and
  - (4)(A) Twenty-five percent (25%) of the disposal fees collected from landfills where a private industry bears the expense of operating and maintaining the landfill solely for the disposal of wastes generated by the industry shall be deposited into a special fund to be created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and to be known as the "Marketing Board Fund".
- 27 (B) The fund shall be administered by the department and 28 used by the State Marketing Board for Recyclables for the administration and 29 performance of its duties—; and
- 30 (5) Beginning July 1, 2012, excluding the disposal fees that are

          SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

     CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE OF
     CONTINGENCY APPROPRIATION AND FUNDING. In the event additional appropriation

     becomes necessary that is not authorized or contemplated in Section 2 of this

     Act and circumstances make it necessary for the Arkansas Crime Information

     Center to request additional appropriation to carry out the objectives of the

     Agency, the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be used for

     Funding for the Contingency Appropriation authorized herein may be

       Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

     the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by

     has determined that the Arkansas Crime Information Center may operate more

     efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Crime Information

     necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by
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requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.

If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
this entire section is void.

SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
