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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
24 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2012-2013 fiscal year, the

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10 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

12 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
 13 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & General Operations Classifications
 14 in the Operations Appropriation provided by this Act, up to an amount not to
 15 exceed \$2,500 each fiscal year, promotional items, authorized by the Director
 16 of the Department to meet requirements of the Arkansas State Police Strategic
 17 Recruitment Plan.

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21 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT

23 AWARDS FUND TRANSFER PROVISION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund
 24 each fiscal year may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes
 25 and/or motor vehicle equipping and renovation costs, agency operational needs
 26 and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police.

27 Provided however, funds received from the Special State Assets Forfeiture
 28 Fund shall be deposited into the Court Awards Fund to be used by the
 29 Department of Arkansas State Police for law enforcement purposes consistent
 30 with governing federal law. The Department of Arkansas State Police may also
 31 request a fund transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the Department of
 32 Arkansas State Police Fund to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund.
 33 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval
 34 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

35 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
 36 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year

1 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
2 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
3 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
4 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
5 has determined that the Department of Arkansas State Police may operate more
6 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Arkansas
7 State Police authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
8 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
9 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget

20 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized,
21 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to
22 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds
23 Transfer" to the Maintenance and General Operations classifications
24 established in the operations appropriation of the Department of Arkansas
25 State Police, and may be used for motor vehicle purchases and associated
26 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational
27 needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police.
28 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department
29 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as
30 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.
31 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval
32 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

33 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
34 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
35 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
36 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

1 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
2 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly

18 VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At
19 least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues and/or general improvement
20 funds deposited into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be
21 used for motor vehicle purchases and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for
22 the Department of Arkansas State Police.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
24 ~~2010~~2012 through June 30, ~~2011~~2013.

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26 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.
28 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime
29 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to
30 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be
31 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to
32 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable
33 to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the
34 Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime
35 payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be
36 in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
2 ~~2010~~2012 through June 30, ~~2011~~2013.

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4 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR
6 VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
7 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for
8 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act.
9 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles used
10 for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the maximum
11 number of authorized passenger vehicles.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
13 ~~2010~~2012 through June 30, ~~2011~~2013.

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15 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM
17 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas
18 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer
19 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
20 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee
21 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the
22 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims
23 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined
24 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance
25 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the
26 department, the 88th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and
27 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide
28 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public
29 employees insurance program.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
31 ~~2010~~2012 through June 30, ~~2011~~2013.

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33 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
35 EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSES. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby
36 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & Operations Classifications in the

1 Operations Appropriation provided by in this Act, up to an amount not to
2 exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) each fiscal year, for
3 emergency purchases for food, drinks and other essential items during
4 emergency operations only when authorized by the Agency Director. During an
5 emergency, an ASP employee may be designated and authorized, by the Director,
6 to incur expenses for all deployed personnel.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
8 ~~2010~~2012 through June 30, ~~2011~~2013.

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10 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FLAGS.
12 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to award one (1)
13 United States flag to the family of any Arkansas State Police Commissioned
14 Officer killed in the line of duty. This provision will be effective for
15 Arkansas State Police Commissioned Officers killed in the line of duty after
16 July 1, 2011.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
18 ~~2011~~2012 to June 30, ~~2012~~2013.

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20 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
21 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
22 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
23 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
24 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
25 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
26 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
27 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
28 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

29
30 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
31 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
32 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
33 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
34 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
35 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
36 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

2

3 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 4 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
 5 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 6 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2012 is essential to the operation of
 7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 8 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
 9 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2012 could work irreparable harm
 10 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
 11 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
 12 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
 13 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2012.
