15	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-7-710(e), concerning survivor annuity		
16	benefits, is repealed.		
17	(e) Annuities payable under this section shall begin the first day of		
18	the calendar month following the date the survivor annuity is payable as		
19	provided in this section.

21	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
22	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions of the Arkansas		
23	Teacher Retirement System Act are in need of revision and updating to		
24	maintain the act in conformance with sound public pension policy; that the		
25	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates on a July 1 to June 30 fiscal		
26	year; and that these provisions are necessary to provide proper		
27	administration to benefits to begin on the first day of the fiscal year; that		
28	such revisions and updating are of great importance for actuarial purposes		
29	and to protect the benefits for members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement		
30	System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being		
31	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
32	become effective on July 1, 2013.
