11 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. 5 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 6 INTER-7 AGENCY TRANSFER OF STATE GENERAL REVENUE FOR TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR NEEDY 8 FAMILIES (TANF) PROGRAMS. Upon the request of the Director of the Department 9 of Human Services and the Director of the Department of Workforce Services 10 (DWS), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may approve up to \$3,640,650 in 11 State General Revenue appropriated to DWS for the TANF Program to be 12 transferred to the Department of Human Services - Division of County 13 Operations in support of Arkansas' Temporary Assistance for Needy Families 14 (TANF) Programs or any related Separate State Programs. 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23 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DIVISION 25 OF COUNTY OPERATIONS - STATE AND FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATIONS. It will be 26 permissible for the Division of County Operations to implement the following 27 exemptions in the event that a State or Federal Disaster is declared: (1) 28 Exceed the 240 hour per quarter limit on the purchase of temporary help; and, 29 (2) Waive the 1,000 hour limit per State Fiscal Year for Extra Help 30 positions.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2012
<u>2013</u> through June 30, 2014.

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34 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16

17 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 19 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of 20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 21 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 27 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013. 28 29 30 31 32

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
