13	SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TUITION
15	REIMBURSEMENT. The Board of Trustees of Southern Arkansas University shall
16	be authorized to reimburse tuition, fees, and other educational related
17	expenses of current faculty who seek additional education levels that will
18	benefit the university in meeting accreditation and professional standards.
19	Reimbursement shall be authorized only when the reimbursement request has
20	been documented by the institution to meet critical shortage instructional
21	areas.
22	
23	SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
25	ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees at Southern Arkansas University may make
26	special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in
27	an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per fiscal year for any one coach, to be
28	expended from auxiliary income. Further, if the special allowance funds
29	authorized herein are utilized, Southern Arkansas University shall report
30	annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of
31	those special allowance funds.
32	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2013,
33	through June 30, 2014.
34	
35	SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
36	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

1 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 2 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 5 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 6 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 7 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 8 with in disbursement of said funds. 9 10 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18 19 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm 25 26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013. 30 31 32 33 34 35
