10	enforcement officer in accordance with the commission; and		
11	(2) Specifically <u>Is</u> authorized in writing <u>as exempt from the</u>		
12	licensing requirements of this subchapter by the auxiliary law enforcement		
13	officer's chief of police or county sheriff.		
14	(c) The authorization prescribed in $\underline{\text{subdivision}}$ (b)(2) of this section		
15	shall be carried on the person of the auxiliary law enforcement officer and		
16	be produced upon demand at the request of any law enforcement officer or		
17	owner or operator of any of the prohibited places as set out in $\S 5-73-306$.

19	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-15-201, concerning definitions related		
20	to concealed handgun permits, is amended to add new definitions to read as		
21	follows:		
22	(3) "Auxiliary law enforcement officer" means a person certified		
23	by the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training and		
24	approved by the county sheriff or chief of police of a municipality where he		
25	or she is acting as an auxiliary law enforcement officer if:		
26	(A) The auxiliary law enforcement officer has completed		
27	the minimum training requirements and is certified as an auxiliary law		
28	enforcement officer in accordance with the commission; and		
29	(B) The chief of police of the law enforcement agency or		
30	county sheriff authorizes the status of the auxiliary law enforcement officer		
31	and the authorization is:		
32	(i) In writing;		
33	(ii) In the possession of the auxiliary law		
34	enforcement officer; and		
35	(iii) Produced upon demand at the request of any la		
36	enforcement officer or owner or operator of any of the prohibited places

2	(4) "In good standing" means that the person:		
3	(A) Was not terminated;		
4	(B) Did not resign in lieu of termination; or		
5	(C) Was not subject to a pending disciplinary action or		
6	criminal investigation at the time of his or her retirement or resignation		
7	from the public law enforcement department, office, or agency.

9	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202(a) and (b), concerning the		
10	eligibility to carry a concealed handgun for law enforcement officers, are		
11	amended to read as follows:		
12	(a) Any certified law enforcement officer or auxiliary law enforcement		
13	officer acting as an auxiliary law enforcement officer may carry a concealed		
14	handgun if that officer is:		
15	(1) Presently Is presently in the employ of a public law		
16	enforcement department, office, or agency;		
17	(2) Authorized Is authorized by the public law enforcement		
18	department, office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of		
19	his or her duties;		
20	(3) Not Is not subject to any disciplinary action that suspends		
21	his or her authority as a law enforcement officer by the public law		
22	enforcement department, office, or agency;		
23	(4) Carrying Is carrying a badge and appropriate written		
24	photographic identification issued by the public law enforcement department,		
25	office, or agency identifying him or her as a certified law enforcement		
26	officer; and		
27	(5) Not Is not otherwise prohibited under federal law-;		
28	(6) Is not under the influence of alcohol or another		
29	intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance; and		
30	(7) Has fingerprint impressions on file with the Department of		
31	Arkansas State Police Automated Fingerprint Identification System.		
32	(b)(1) A concealed handgun may be carried by any retired law		
33	enforcement officer or retired auxiliary law enforcement officer acting as a		
34	retired auxiliary law enforcement officer who:		
35	(A) Retired <u>in good standing</u> from service with a public		
36	law enforcement department, office, or agency for reasons other than mental		

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1	disability;		
2	(B) Immediately before retirement was a certified law		
3	enforcement officer authorized by a public law enforcement department,		
4	office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her		
5	duties;		
6	(C) Is carrying appropriate written photographic		
7	identification issued by a public law enforcement department, office, or		
8	agency identifying him or her as a retired and former certified law		
9	enforcement officer;		
10	(D) Is not otherwise prohibited under federal law from		
11	receiving or possessing a firearm;		
12	(E) Has fingerprint impressions on file with the		
13	Department of Arkansas State Police <u>Automated Fingerprint Identification</u>		
14	System together with written authorization for state and national level		
15	criminal history record screening; and		
16	(F) During the most recent twelve-month period has met, at		
17	the expense of the retired law enforcement officer, the standards of this		
18	state for training and qualification for active law enforcement officers to		
19	carry firearms-:		
20	(G) Before his or her retirement, worked or was employed		
21	as a law enforcement officer or acted as an auxiliary law enforcement officer		
22	for an aggregate of ten (10) years or more; and		
23	(H) Is not under the influence of alcohol or another		
24	intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance.		
25	(2)(A) The chief law enforcement officer of the city or county		
26	shall keep a record of all retired law enforcement officers authorized to		
27	carry a concealed handgun in his or her jurisdiction and shall revoke any		
28	authorization for good cause shown.		
29	(B) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State		
30	Police shall keep a record of all retired department officers authorized to		
31	carry a concealed handgun in the state and shall revoke any authorization for		
32	good cause shown.
