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1	(c) To facilitate expeditious resolution, the insurer shall provide,		
2	upon request, a written communication to the treating dentist with the name,		
3	state where licensed, license number, and direct telephone number of the		
4	reviewing dentist.		
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6	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
7	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that only licensed dentists should be		
8	permitted to deny claims; that there are no standards in place governing		
9	denial of dental claims; and that this void endangers the health of Arkansans		
10	in need of dental services. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and		
11	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
12	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
13	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
14	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
15	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
16	bill; or		
17	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
18	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."		
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
