19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-17-108 is amended to read as follows:

22 16-17-108. Salaries of personnel and other requirements of various
23 district courts. [Effective January 1, 2012.]

24 (a) Unless otherwise provided by law, the salaries of the judges and
25 other personnel of the various district courts shall be established as
26 follows:

27 (1) The Arkansas County District Court – Northern District Judge
28 shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars
29 (\$35,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), the district court
30 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand eight
31 hundred thirty-four dollars and ninety-two cents (\$13,834.92) nor more than
32 thirty-four thousand dollars (\$34,000), and the deputy court clerk shall
33 receive an annual salary of not less than eleven thousand four hundred
34 seventy-five dollars (\$11,475) nor more than twenty-eight thousand dollars
35 (\$28,000). The salaries shall be as determined by the governing body of the
36 City of Stuttgart and the Arkansas County Quorum Court and paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$)



1 by the city and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the county;

2 (2) The Arkansas County District Court – Southern District Judge
3 shall receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand dollars
4 (\$13,000) nor more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), the district court
5 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand five
6 hundred dollars (\$12,500) nor more than thirty-four thousand dollars
7 (\$34,000), and the deputy clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less
8 than ten thousand five hundred dollars (\$10,500) nor more than twenty-eight
9 thousand dollars (\$28,000). The salaries shall be determined by the governing
10 body of the City of DeWitt and the Arkansas County Quorum Court and paid one-
11 half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the city and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the county;

12 (3) The Ashley County District Court – Crossett Department Judge
13 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars
14 (\$20,000) nor more than thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$38,000), and the
15 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen
16 thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars
17 (\$25,000). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range prescribed in
18 this subdivision (a)(3), as agreed upon by the Ashley County Quorum Court and
19 the governing body of the City of Crossett;

20 (4) The Ashley County District Court – Hamburg Department Judge
21 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars
22 (\$20,000) nor more than thirty-eight thousand dollars (\$38,000), and the
23 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen
24 thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars
25 (\$25,000). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range prescribed in
26 this subdivision (a)(4), as agreed upon by the Ashley County Quorum Court and
27 the governing body of the City of Hamburg;

28 (5) The Baxter County District Court Clerk shall receive
29 compensation in an amount as may be provided by the City of Mountain Home and
30 the Baxter County Quorum Court. The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the
31 City of Mountain Home and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Baxter County;

32 (6) The Bradley County District Court Judge shall receive an
33 annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more
34 than thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000), as established by the Bradley
35 County Quorum Court and approved by the governing body of the City of Warren;

36 (7)(A) The Calhoun County District Court ~~Judge shall receive an~~

1 ~~annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more~~
2 ~~than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) and the clerk Clerk of the court shall~~
3 receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000)
4 nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be determined by
5 the Hampton City Council and the Calhoun County Quorum Court.

6 (B) The salaries shall be paid by the City of Hampton and
7 Calhoun County in equal monthly installments;

8 (8) The Camden District Court Judge shall receive an annual
9 salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than fifty
10 thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be paid by the City of Camden and Ouachita
11 County;

12 (9) The Carroll County District Court – Eastern District Judge
13 shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars
14 (\$16,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000);

15 (10) The Carroll County District Court – Western District Judge
16 shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars
17 (\$16,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000);

18 (11)(A) The Chicot County District Court – Dermott Department
19 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand
20 dollars (\$18,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000).

21 (B)(i) The court clerk shall receive an annual salary of
22 not less than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than twenty
23 thousand dollars (\$20,000).

24 (ii) However, the court clerk's position shall be a
25 full-time or part-time position.

26 (C) The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
27 prescribed in this subdivision (a)(11) as agreed upon by the Chicot County
28 Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Dermott.

29 (D) The salary of the district court judge and the salary
30 of the district court clerk shall be paid as follows:

31 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
32 Dermott; and

33 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
34 County;

35 (12)(A) The Chicot County District Court – Eudora Department
36 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand

1 dollars (\$18,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000), and
 2 the district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than
 3 fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than twenty thousand dollars
 4 (\$20,000).

5 (B) The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
 6 prescribed in subdivision (a)(12)(A) of this section as agreed upon by the
 7 Chicot County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Eudora.

8 (C) The salary of the judge and the salary of the clerk
 9 shall be paid as follows:

10 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
 11 Eudora; and

12 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
 13 County;

14 (13)(A) The Chicot County District Court – Lake Village
 15 Department Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen
 16 thousand dollars (\$18,000) nor more than twenty-six thousand dollars
 17 (\$26,000), and the court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less
 18 than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than twenty thousand
 19 dollars (\$20,000). If authorized by the governing body of the City of Lake
 20 Village and the Chicot County Quorum Court, the judge shall be authorized to
 21 employ a full-time or part-time deputy court clerk at an annual salary of not
 22 less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) nor more than twelve thousand
 23 dollars (\$12,000). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
 24 prescribed in this subdivision (a)(13)(A), as agreed upon by the Chicot
 25 County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Lake Village.

26 (B) The salary of the judge and the salary of the clerk
 27 shall be paid as follows:

28 (i) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by the City of
 29 Lake Village; and

30 (ii) Fifty percent (50%) to be paid by Chicot
 31 County;

32 (14) ~~The Clark County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
 33 ~~annual salary of not less than fifty-three thousand five hundred dollars~~
 34 ~~(\$53,500) nor more than sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000), and the Clark~~
 35 ~~County District Court~~ Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than
 36 twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) nor more than thirty-eight thousand

1 dollars (\$38,000), such salaries to be established annually by the Clark
 2 County Quorum Court. Upon approval by the Clark County Quorum Court, the
 3 Clark County District Court Judge may appoint one (1) deputy district court
 4 clerk to receive a salary as established by the Clark County Quorum Court;

5 (15)(A) The Clay County District Court Judge shall receive an
 6 annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) nor more
 7 than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), to be paid, as well as other current
 8 benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.

9 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
 10 by the City of Corning, the City of Piggott, and the City of Rector at
 11 eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%), eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%),
 12 and thirteen percent (13%), respectively, to the county treasury.

13 (C) The clerks of the respective district courts shall
 14 receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars
 15 (\$4,500) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), to be paid, as
 16 well as other current benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay County.

17 (D) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
 18 by the respective cities;

19 (16) ~~The Cleveland County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
 20 ~~annual salary of not less than nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000) nor more~~
 21 ~~than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and the district court clerk Clerk~~
 22 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars
 23 (\$12,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be
 24 determined by the Rison City Council and the Cleveland County Quorum Court;

25 (17) The Columbia County District Court Judge shall receive an
 26 annual salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor
 27 more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). Any salaries paid over the
 28 minimum salaries set in this subdivision (a)(17) shall be paid only upon the
 29 approval of the governing bodies of the City of Magnolia and Columbia County;

30 (18) The Conway County District Court Judge shall receive an
 31 annual salary of not less than thirty-two thousand five hundred dollars
 32 (\$32,500) nor more than thirty-eight thousand five hundred dollars (\$38,500).
 33 However, the salary may be increased by such an amount as may be agreed to by
 34 the Conway County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of
 35 Morrilton by ordinances adopted by their respective bodies;

36 (19)(A) ~~The Craighead County District Court Judge shall be a~~

1 ~~full-time district judge and shall receive as compensation for services an~~
 2 ~~annual salary of not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) nor~~
 3 ~~more than one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000), as determined by~~
 4 ~~the Craighead County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of~~
 5 ~~Jonesboro, to be paid in equal monthly installments. The amount of the salary~~
 6 ~~shall be appropriated by ordinance adopted by the Craighead County Quorum~~
 7 ~~Court. The amount of the salary and necessary expenses appropriated for the~~
 8 ~~court shall be apportioned among and paid to the county from the respective~~
 9 ~~cities of the first class and cities of the second class, incorporated towns,~~
 10 ~~and the government of Craighead County as a prorated amount based on the~~
 11 ~~number of cases filed from each of the towns and cities and the county during~~
 12 ~~the preceding calendar year. Apportionment of the costs of the court shall be~~
 13 ~~by order of the district court upon certification of the cases filed by the~~
 14 ~~Clerk of the Craighead County District Court.~~

15 ~~(B)(A)~~ The Craighead County District Court Judge shall
 16 maintain dockets and hold court, as deemed necessary, in each of the county
 17 seats of Craighead County and may establish dockets and hold court in other
 18 cities and towns in Craighead County, as deemed necessary by ordinance
 19 adopted by the Craighead County Quorum Court;.

20 (B) Necessary expenses appropriated for the court shall be
 21 apportioned among and paid to the county from the respective cities of the
 22 first class and cities of the second class, incorporated towns, and the
 23 government of Craighead County as a prorated amount based on the number of
 24 cases filed from each of the towns and cities and the county during the
 25 preceding calendar year;

26 ~~(20) The Crawford County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
 27 ~~annual salary of not less than eighty-two thousand dollars (\$82,000) nor more~~
 28 ~~than one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000);~~

29 ~~(21)(19)~~ The Cross County District Court Judge shall receive an
 30 annual salary of not less than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000) nor
 31 more than forty-four thousand dollars (\$44,000). This salary and the salaries
 32 of all court employees shall be as determined by the governing body of the
 33 City of Wynne;

34 ~~(22)(20)~~ The Dallas County District Court Judge shall receive an
 35 ~~annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more~~
 36 ~~than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and each clerk Clerks of the court~~

1 shall receive an annual salary of not less than fifteen thousand dollars
2 (\$15,000) nor more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), as may be
3 determined by the Fordyce City Council and the Dallas County Quorum Court,
4 and the salaries shall be paid by the City of Fordyce and Dallas County in
5 equal monthly installments;

6 ~~(23)~~(21) The Desha County District Court – Dumas Department
7 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-seven thousand
8 five hundred dollars (\$27,500) nor more than forty-five thousand dollars
9 (\$45,000). The clerk of the court shall receive an annual salary of not less
10 than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) nor more than thirty thousand
11 dollars (\$30,000), and the deputy clerk shall receive an annual salary of not
12 less than fourteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$14,500) nor more than
13 twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000). The salaries shall be paid one-half
14 ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the Desha County Quorum Court and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Dumas
15 and shall be determined by the Desha County Quorum Court and the governing
16 body of the City of Dumas;

17 ~~(24)~~(22) The Desha County District Court – McGehee Department
18 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-seven thousand
19 five hundred dollars (\$27,500) nor more than forty-five thousand dollars
20 (\$45,000). The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the Desha County Quorum
21 Court and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of McGehee and shall be determined by the
22 Desha County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of McGehee. The
23 district court clerk shall be employed and paid by the City of McGehee at
24 such a salary as the governing body shall determine;

25 ~~(25)~~(23) The Drew County District Court Judge shall receive an
26 annual salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more
27 than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). The salary shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$)
28 by the City of Monticello and one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Drew County in the amount as
29 may be agreed to by the Drew County Quorum Court and the governing body of
30 the City of Monticello;

31 ~~(26)~~(24) The East Camden District Court Judge shall receive an
32 annual salary of not less than three thousand eight hundred fifty-nine
33 dollars (\$3,859) nor more than twenty-three thousand dollars (\$23,000), to be
34 paid by the City of East Camden;

35 ~~(27)~~(25) The Elkins District Court Judge shall receive an annual
36 salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than

1 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000). The annual salary for each clerk of
2 the court shall be not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than
3 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000);

4 ~~(28) The Faulkner County District Court Judge shall receive an~~
5 ~~annual salary of not less than seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) nor more~~
6 ~~than one hundred twelve thousand dollars (\$112,000);~~

7 ~~(29)~~(26) The Fayetteville District Court Judge shall receive an
8 annual salary of not less than eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) nor more
9 than one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$135,000);

10 ~~(30)~~(27) The Franklin County District Court – Charleston
11 District Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand
12 dollars (\$10,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). The
13 salaries and costs may be set and the payment may be apportioned by agreement
14 between the governing body of the City of Charleston and the Franklin County
15 Quorum Court;

16 ~~(31)~~(28) The Franklin County District Court – Ozark District
17 Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand six
18 hundred dollars (\$22,600) nor more than thirty-five thousand dollars
19 (\$35,000). The salary and costs may be set and the payment thereof may be
20 apportioned by agreement between the governing body of the City of Ozark and
21 the Franklin County Quorum Court;

22 ~~(32)~~(29) The Fulton County District Court Judge shall receive an
23 annual salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) nor more
24 than thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000). The annual salary of the Fulton
25 County District Court Clerk shall be not less than fifteen thousand three
26 hundred dollars (\$15,300) nor more than twenty-two thousand dollars
27 (\$22,000). The expense of salaries, along with all other necessary and
28 customary expenses of the court, shall be shared by Fulton County, the City
29 of Salem, and the City of Mammoth Spring, based on a percentage of the actual
30 number of cases handled through the court for each governmental entity. The
31 percentage shall be determined annually by dividing the total number of cases
32 handled by the court into the number of cases handled annually for each of
33 the aforementioned governmental entities. On January 1 of each year, each
34 share shall be estimated based on the number of cases handled by the court
35 for each of the respective governmental entities for the preceding year.
36 However, on December 31 of each year, each share shall be adjusted to reflect

1 the actual percentage for each governmental entity for that year based on the
2 actual case load. The salaries and expenses shall be paid in equal monthly
3 installments by Fulton County, and the City of Salem and the City of Mammoth
4 Spring shall reimburse the county on a monthly basis for their respective
5 shares of salaries and expenses;

6 ~~(33)~~(30) The Garland County District Court Judges, Departments 1
7 and 2, shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixty-five thousand
8 dollars (\$65,000) nor more than eighty-six thousand dollars (\$86,000), and
9 the Garland County District Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not
10 less than twenty-six thousand dollars (\$26,000) nor more than fifty-two
11 thousand dollars (\$52,000). The salaries shall be determined by the governing
12 body of the City of Hot Springs and the Garland County Quorum Court;

13 ~~(34)(A)~~(31)(A) The Grant County District Court Judge shall
14 receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor
15 more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), as approved by the Grant County
16 Quorum Court.

17 (B) The Grant County District Court Clerk shall receive an
18 annual salary of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) nor more
19 than thirty-six thousand dollars (\$36,000), as approved by the Grant County
20 Quorum Court.

21 (C) The district court judge's and clerk's salary shall be
22 paid as follows:

23 (i) Twenty-seven percent (27%) to be paid by the
24 City of Sheridan; and

25 (ii) Seventy-three percent (73%) to be paid by Grant
26 County;

27 ~~(35)~~(32) The Greene County District Court – Paragould District
28 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than nineteen thousand eight
29 hundred fifty-six dollars (\$19,856) nor more than forty thousand dollars
30 (\$40,000), the chief deputy clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less
31 than sixteen thousand six hundred twenty-four dollars (\$16,624) nor more than
32 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), and the deputy clerk shall receive an
33 annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand three hundred fourteen
34 dollars (\$13,314) nor more than thirty-two thousand dollars (\$32,000). The
35 salaries shall be determined by the Greene County Quorum Court and the
36 governing body of the City of Paragould and shall be paid in twelve (12)

1 equal monthly installments;

2 ~~(36)~~(33) The Hempstead County District Court Judge shall receive
3 an annual salary of not less than thirty-seven thousand five hundred dollars
4 ~~(\$37,500), beginning January 1996, nor more than forty-five thousand dollars~~
5 ~~(\$45,000), and the district court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not~~
6 less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor more than thirty
7 thousand dollars (\$30,000). The amount of the ~~salaries~~ salary shall be
8 determined by agreement between the governing body of the City of Hope and
9 the Hempstead County Quorum Court;

10 ~~(37)~~(34) The Hot Spring County District Court Judge shall
11 receive an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars
12 (\$35,000) nor more than fifty-nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$59,500),
13 as prescribed by the governing body of the City of Malvern and the Hot Spring
14 County Quorum Court, and provided further, that the first seventeen thousand
15 five hundred dollars (\$17,500) shall be paid fifty percent (50%) by the city
16 and fifty percent (50%) by the county, and that portion of the annual salary
17 in excess of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars (\$17,500) shall be paid
18 by the city and county in the same proportion that the city and county shared
19 in the revenues generated by the court in the previous year. Furthermore, the
20 Hot Spring County District Court Judge shall be entitled to an additional
21 deputy district court clerk whose salary shall be determined by the governing
22 body of the City of Malvern and the Hot Spring County Quorum Court, and the
23 salary shall be paid by the city and county in the same proportion as the
24 city and county shared in the revenues generated by the court in the previous
25 year;

26 ~~(38)~~(35) The Howard County District Court Judge shall have an
27 annual salary of not less than twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000). The
28 Howard County District Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less
29 than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more than nineteen thousand
30 dollars (\$19,000), unless provided for otherwise by ordinance of the Howard
31 County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Nashville. The
32 salaries are to be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Nashville and one-half
33 ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Howard County;

34 ~~(39)~~(36) The IZard County District Court Judge shall receive an
35 annual salary of not less than ten thousand two hundred dollars (\$10,200) nor
36 more than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000), and the district court

1 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven thousand four
 2 hundred dollars (\$7,400) nor more than twenty-eight thousand dollars
 3 (\$28,000). However, the salaries shall be subject to the approval of the
 4 Melbourne City Council and the Izard County Quorum Court;

5 ~~(40)~~(37) The Jackson County District Court Judge shall receive
 6 an annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) nor
 7 more than fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000). The salary of the district
 8 court judge shall be paid one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) by the City of Newport and one-half
 9 ($\frac{1}{2}$) by Jackson County;

10 ~~(41)~~(38) The Jacksonville District Court Clerk shall receive an
 11 annual salary of not less than thirty-three thousand nine hundred thirty-
 12 seven dollars (\$33,937) nor more than thirty-six thousand nine hundred
 13 dollars (\$36,900);

14 ~~(42)~~(39) The Jasper District Court Judge shall receive an annual
 15 salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more than
 16 twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500), and the clerk shall
 17 receive an annual salary of not less than thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000)
 18 nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000). All salaries and all other
 19 expenses of the office shall be paid one hundred percent (100%) by the
 20 county;

 22 ~~receive an annual salary of not less than eighty-five thousand dollars~~
 23 ~~(\$85,000) nor more than ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000), as may be~~
 24 ~~approved by the Jefferson County Quorum Court and the governing body of the~~
