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7	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8	Assembly that the process for conducting abuse registry checks for vulnerable
9	citizens does not provide timely access to the release of registry
10	information for the protection of those citizens; and that this act is
11	necessary because the lapse in time that creates an threat to vulnerable
12	citizens will be remedied through registry information made more accessible
13	through automation. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and
14	this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
15	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
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
