16	REGARDING PROTECTION OF AGRICULTURAL
17	EQUIPMENT AND IMPLEMENTS; AND TO REGULATE
18	TRANSACTIONS INVOLVING CERTAIN METALS
19	ASSOCIATED WITH AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION.

22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23	
24	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>Legislative intent.</u>
25	It is the intent of the General Assembly to protect the state's
26	agricultural producers and farmers from the destruction of their equipment
27	and implements due to purposeful destruction by persons stripping equipment
28	and implements for copper.
29	
30	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 44, is amended to add
31	additional new sections to read as follows:
32	17-44-107. Regulation of copper sellers.
33	(a)(1) A county quorum court may pass an ordinance that would require
34	a seller of copper to obtain a permit from the county sheriff to sell any
35	amount of copper to a scrap metal recycler.
36	(2) The application for the permit shall require the following

1	information:
2	(A) The person's:
3	<u>(i) Name;</u>
4	(ii) Physical mailing address;
5	(iii) Contact phone number;
6	(iv) Vehicle license plate number; and
7	(v) Driver's license number;
8	(B) The make and model of the person's vehicle;
9	(C) A picture of the copper to be sold; and
10	(D) The name of the county in which the person intends to
11	sell the copper to a scrap metal recycler.
12	(b) A person who holds a heating, ventilation, and air conditioning
13	license, a plumber's license, an electrician's license, or a general
14	contractor's license is exempt from the requirements of this section.
15	
16	17-44-108. Transactions or acquisitions involving copper — Certain
17	<u>cash sales prohibited.</u>
18	(a)(1) A scrap metal recycler subject to the requirements of this
19	chapter is prohibited from purchasing or otherwise acquiring more than five
20	pounds (5 lbs.) of copper from a seller within a twenty-four (24) hour period
21	by performing a cash in hand transaction.
22	(2) All transactions for the sale or purchase of more than five
23	pounds (5 lbs.) of copper by a scrap metal recycler shall be paid for by
24	<u>check.</u>
25	(b) A person who violates this section is upon conviction guilty of a
26	Class A misdemeanor.
