## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS FAIR HOUSING ACT; TO  
ENSURE ALL PERSONS ARE TREATED FAIRLY UNDER LAW BY  
ADDING ECONOMIC STATUS AND SOURCE OF INCOME TO  
EXISTING CIVIL RIGHTS PROTECTIONS; TO ALLOW FOR STATE  
ENFORCEMENT OF FAIR EMPLOYMENT AND PUBLIC  
ACCOMMODATIONS PRACTICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS FAIR HOUSING ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is amend the Arkansas Fair Housing Act, § 16-123-201 et seq., to ensure all persons are treated fairly under law by adding economic status and source of income to existing civil rights protections, and to allow for state enforcement of fair employment and public accommodations practices.
