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- 33 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 26-51-501(f)(1), concerning personal tax 34 credits, is amended to read as follows:

8	SECTION 4. The introductory language of Arkansas Code § 26-57-610(3),		
9	concerning the disposition of insurance premium taxes, is amended to read as		
10	follows:		
11	(3) Amounts collected under §§ 26-57-604 and 26-57-605 above the		
12	forecasted level for insurance premium taxes set by the Chief Fiscal Officer		
13	of the State under § 10-3-1404(a)(1)(A) shall be credited by the Treasurer of		
14	State to the Arkansas Medicaid Program Trust Fund and shall be disbursed and		
15	used for the sole purpose of increasing per diem reimbursement for general		
16	hospital inpatient services provided to Medicaid beneficiaries and to		
17	increase private duty nursing rates for registered nurses and licensed		
18	practical nurses in home health agencies in the following amounts:		
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
