7	HOUSE RESOLUTION
8	TO SUPPORT WESTERN STATES AND THE FEDERAL TRANSFER OF
9	PUBLIC LANDS TO THE WESTERN STATES; AND TO URGE THE
10	UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO ENGAGE IN GOOD FAITH
11	COMMUNICATION AND COOPERATION TO COORDINATE THE
12	TRANSFER OF TITLE TO THE WESTERN STATES.

15	Subtitle
16	TO SUPPORT WESTERN STATES AND THE FEDERAL
17	TRANSFER OF PUBLIC LANDS TO THE WESTERN
18	STATES.
19	
20	WHEREAS, under Article IV, Section 3, of the United States
21	Constitution, "The congress shall have power to dispose of and make all
22	needful rules and regulations respecting the territory or other property
23	belonging to the United States;"; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, the Constitutional Convention intended this provision of the
26	Constitution to maintain the status quo that had been established to transfer
27	federal territorial lands only to create new states with the same rights of
28	sovereignty, freedom, and independence as the original states; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, under these express terms of trust, over time the states
31	claiming federal territorial land ceded their western land to the
32	confederated Union to allow the confederated government to dispose of the
33	lands only to create new states and apply the net proceeds of any sales of
34	the lands only to pay down the public debt; and
35	
36	WHEREAS, the United States Constitution contains no expression of

- 1 intent to authorize the federal government to indefinitely exercise control 2 over western public lands beyond the duty to manage the lands pending the 3 disposal of the lands to create new states, and therefore the lands should be 4 returned to the western states; and 5 6 WHEREAS, in order to promote legitimate federal interests the western 7 states should upon transfer of the public lands directly to the state where 8 the public land is located agree to affirmatively cede lands for the national 9 park system, the national wilderness preservation system, and lands reserved 10 for federal military use, military parks, and military reservations to the 11 federal government under Article I, Section 8, Clause 17, of the United 12 States Constitution, on condition that the lands permanently remain national 13 park lands, and that they not be sold, transferred, left in substantial 14 disrepair, or conveyed to any party other than to the state where the land is 15 located; and 16 17 WHEREAS, limiting the ability of western states to access and utilize 18 the public lands' natural resources within their borders is having a negative 19 impact upon the economy of the western states and therefore the economy of 20 the entire United States, including the State of Arkansas, 21 22 NOW THEREFORE, 23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL 24 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 25 26 THAT in order to provide a fair, just, and equitable remedy for the 27 federal government's past and continuing breaches of its solemn promises to 28 the western states, the House of Representatives: 29 30 (1) Calls on the federal government to transfer title to all 31 federal public lands within the western states to the state where the land is 32 located:
  - (2) Urges the United States Congress to engage in good faith communications, cooperation, and consultation with the western states to coordinate the transfer of the public lands, and supports the western states in these efforts;

1	(3) Calls upon the western states to agree, upon transfer of the
2	public lands, to affirmatively cede to the federal government all lands
3	currently designated as part of the National Park System under 16 U.S.C. §
4	la-1, the National Wilderness Preservation System under 16 U.S.C. § 1131, or
5	for military use, military parks, or military reservations;
6	(4) Urges that if any public land in the western states be sold
7	to private owners, the net proceeds be paid to the Bureau of the Public Debt
8	to pay down the federal debt; and
9	(5) Calls on all other states of the United States to pass a
10	similar resolution in support of the transfer of the federal public lands to
11	the western states.
12	
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT upon its adoption copies of this resolution be
14	sent to the United States Department of the Interior, the Majority Leader of
15	the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of
16	Representatives, the members of the Arkansas Congressional Delegation, and
17	the Governors, Senate Presidents, and Speakers of the House of
18	Representatives of the 49 other states.
