1	(4) "Legislative Instructions" means instructions regarding the
2	permitted scope of the convention given by the state legislature to delegates
3	and alternates;
4	(5)(A) "Unauthorized amendment" means a proposed amendment that:
5	(i) Varies from the same proposed and permitted
6	amendment text as stated in the particular Article V Application under
7	consideration; or
8	(ii) Is outside the permitted subject matter as
9	$\underline{\text{stated}}$ in the Article V Application and as further defined by the Legislative
10	<u>Instructions.</u>
11	(B) If a state has not passed an Article V Resolution
12	relied on by Congress to call the Article V Convention, an unauthorized
13	amendment shall be an amendment other than the exact text permitted by each
14	and all of the thirty-four (34) Article V Applications relied on by Congress
15	to propose the convention or outside the permitted subject matter as defined
16	the Legislative Instructions of this state, or any of the Article V
17	Applications relied on by Congress to call the Convention.

19	7-9-603. Delegates to Article V Convention — Duties and limitations.
20	(a) No delegate from Arkansas to an Article V Convention shall have
21	the authority to vote to allow consideration of, consider or approve an
22	unauthorized amendment for ratification to the Constitution of the United
23	States of America.
24	(b) Any delegate casting or attempting to cast a vote to allow
25	consideration of, consider, or approve an unauthorized amendment shall be
26	immediately ineligible to serve as a delegate, and shall be immediately
27	replaced by an alternate as provided by law.
28	(c) Any vote cast or attempted to be cast by a delegate from Arkansas
29	in violation of this sections shall be null and void.
30	(d) Every candidate and person under consideration for selection for
31	delegate or alternate from Arkansas to the Article V convention shall be
32	required to take the following oath: "I do solemnly swear or affirm that to
33	the best of my abilities, I will, as a delegate or alternate to an Article V
34	convention, uphold the Constitution and the laws of the United States of
35	America and the State of Arkansas. I will not vote to allow consideration
36	of, consider or approve any unauthorized amendment proposed for ratification

1	to the United States of America Constitution. I understand that violation of	
2	this oath will result in my immediate recall and replacement at the Article V	
3	Convention and that additional criminal penalties may be imposed on me by	
4	Arkansas law."	
5	(e) The State Legislature or an official or committee authorized by a	
6	joint resolution of the State Legislature shall certify the selection of	
7	Arkansas delegates and alternates in writing to each delegate and alternate	
8	and shall provide a copy of the certification to the Article V Convention.	
9	(f) No delegate shall have authority to vote or otherwise serve as a	
10	delegate at the Article V Convention without the certification as a delegate.	
11	(g) If a delegate becomes ineligible to serve, that delegate's	
12	certification shall no longer be valid and the alternate delegate, as	
13	provided by law shall immediately be entitled to represent Arkansas as a	
14	delegate in place of the delegate who has become ineligible. The state	
15	legislature or an official or committee authorized by a joint resolution of	
16	the State Legislature shall immediately provide certification to the new	
17	delegate and notify the Article V Convention of the change in certification	
18	and of any unauthorized votes which must be considered null and void.	
19	(h) The state legislature shall provide guidance upon the request of	
20	any delegate or alternate delegate as to whether a proposed amendment is	
21	within the permitted subject matter of the convention.	
22	(i)(l) Any delegate who knowingly and willfully violates the oath	
23	contained in this section shall be guilty of usurping, overturning, or	
24	seizing government under § 5-51-204 a class B felony.	
25	(2) A person convicted of a violation of subsection (i) of this	
26	section is barred from holding public office or state employment from the	
27	date of his or her conviction.	
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
