20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 3, Chapter 5, is amended to add an additional		
21	subchapter to read as	follows:	
22	3-5-1701. Titl	<u>e.</u>	
23	This subchapter	shall be known and may be cited as	the "Direct Shipment
24	of Wine Act".

26	3-5-1702. Defi	nitions.	
27	As used in this	section:	
28	<u>(1) "Per</u>	son" means one (1) or more natural pe	ersons, a company,
29	corporation, partners	hip, or association;	
30	<u>(2) "Sma</u>	11 farm winery" means a wine-making o	establishment that
31	sells no more than tw	o hundred fifty thousand (250,000) ga	allons of wine
32	-	on the United States Department of the	
33		rade Bureau form 5120.17 or its succe	
34		e" means any fermented alcoholic liqu	
35		ts, honey, or vegetables and having a	
36	ot more than five per	cent (5%) and not more than twenty-or	ne percent (21%) of

3	3-5-1703. Direct shipment of wine and limitations.		
4	(a) A person who possesses a current small farm winery permit issued by		
5	the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division may ship wine to an individual in		
6	this state.		
7	(b) A person with a small farm winery permit shall not ship:		
8	(1) More than twelve (12) nine-liter cases of wine annually to		
9	the same individual in this state;		
10	(2) Wine to an individual who is less than twenty-one (21)		
11	years of age; or		
12	(3)(A) Wine for resale.		
13	(B) Subdivision (b)(3)(A) of this section does not		
14	restrict the sale or delivery of wine for resale as defined and allowed		
15	elsewhere in the Arkansas Code.		
16			
17	3-5-1704. Packaging — Payment of taxes.		
18	A small farm winery shipping wine under this subchapter shall:		
19	(1) Ensure that all containers of wine shipped directly to an		
20	individual in this state are conspicuously labeled with the following words		
21	in at least a 12-point font "SIGNATURE OF PERSON AGE 21 OR OLDER REQUIRED FO		
22	DELIVERY".		
23	(2) Keep the signature of the person twenty-one (21) years of age or		
24	older on file for a period of at least twelve (12) months.		
25	(3) Pay to the Department of Finance and Administration all sales		
26	taxes and excise taxes due on sales to individuals in this state with the		
27	sales and excise taxes calculated as if the sale took place on the premises		
28	of an Arkansas small farm winery, including without limitation taxes under §§		
29	3-5-1605, 3-7-104, 3-7-111, and 3-7-201.		
30			
31	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
32	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that it would enhance the economy		
33	if a small farm wine supplier is allowed to ship limited amounts of wine to a		
34	resident of this state. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and		
35	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
36	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		

1	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
2	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
3	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
4	bill; or
5	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
6	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
