2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the local police retirement
4	systems provide economic security for eligible citizens of Arkansas; that the
5	statutes need amending to update and clarify existing law; and that these
6	changes need to be made immediately. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
7	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
8	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
9	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
10	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
11	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
12	bill; or
13	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
14	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
