31	SECTION 5.	<u>EMER</u>	GENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
32	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the local police and fire				
33	retirement systems provide economic security for eligible citizens of				
34	Arkansas; that the	e sta	tutes need amending to update and clarify existing law;		
35	and that these changes need to be made immediately. Therefore, an emergency				
36	is declared to exi	ist,	and this act being immediately necessary for the		

1	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
2	on:
3	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
4	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
5	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
6	bill; or
7	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
8	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
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
