Funds 8 allocated under the appropriation for community-based services, for Grants to 9 Community Providers, in the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-10 Aid appropriation in this act shall be used only to provide services through 11 private community based services licensed or certified by the Arkansas 12 Division of Developmental Disabilities Services (DDS). Non-profit community-13 based programs licensed by the Division of Developmental Disabilities 14 Services are quasi-governmental instrumentalities of the state which provide 15 supports and services to individuals who have a developmental disability or 16 delay, who would otherwise require supports and services through state-17 operated programs and facilities owned by the State of Arkansas. - 11 Developmental Disabilities Services of the Department of Human Services is
- 12 hereby authorized to provide employment opportunities for people with
- 13 developmental disabilities residing at the Human Development Centers who work
- less than a competitive employment level.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2012
- 16 2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

- 18 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANTS IN
- 20 AID CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING FUNDS. Private non-profit community-based
- 21 programs licensed by the Department of Human Services, Developmental
- 22 Disabilities Services, are eligible to receive funds appropriated for Grants
- 23 to Community Providers in the Developmental Disabilities Services Grants-
- 24 in-Aid appropriation of this Act, and as a condition of receiving such funds
- 25 they shall:
- 1. Meet minimum standards of performance in the delivery of services to
- 27 people with disabilities as defined by the Department of Human Services,
- 28 Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 29 2. Supply statistical and financial data to the Department of Human
- 30 Services, Developmental Disabilities Services.
- 3. Establish and maintain a sound financial management system in accordance
- 32 with guidelines as set forth by the Department of Human Services.
- 4. Establish and maintain community support programs designed to provide
- 34 coordinated care and treatment to ensure ongoing involvement and
- 35 individualized services for persons with disabilities. Every community
- 36 support program shall provide services for persons with disabilities who

- 1 reside within the respective area of the program.
- 2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2012
- 3 2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

- 5 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 7 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND
- 8 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized
- 9 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to
- 10 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be
- 11 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental
- 12 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be
- 13 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities
- 14 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately.
- 15 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to
- 16 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of
- 17 major capital equipment.
- 18 The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all
- 19 income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 20 State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the
- 21 harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the
- 22 Arkansas Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds
- 23 derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant
- 24 state purchasing laws.
- 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July $1, \frac{2012}{}$
- 26 <u>2013</u> through June 30, <u>2013</u> <u>2014</u>.

- 28 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN
- 30 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.
- 31 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of
- 32 Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human
- 33 Development Centers which are located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro,
- 34 Booneville, and Warren.
- 35 (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for
- 36 whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed at

- 2 by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been determined in
- 3 accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the community.
- 4 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based
- 5 services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community
- 6 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services Grants-in-
- 7 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) community based
- 8 services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the
- 9 appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s)
- 10 directly benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.
- 11 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of July $1, \frac{2012}{}$ 2013 from the
- 12 Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities
- 13 Services Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental
- 14 disabilities or from any other general revenues as of July 1, 2012 2013,
- 15 applied as federal matching funds for community based services licensed by
- 16 DDS on July 1, $\frac{2012}{}$ 2013 be reduced below the approved funding level on July
- 17 1, 2012 2013; nor shall the general revenues applied as federal matching
- 18 funds for the Human Development Centers be reduced below the approved funding
- 19 level on July 1, 2012 2013.

- 21 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AUTISM
- 23 TREATMENT AND COORDINATION. The Department of Human Services Division of
- 24 Developmental Disabilities Services shall promulgate rules and regulations
- 25 regarding the licensure and oversight of Applied Behavior Analysts as
- 26 described in Arkansas Code § 23-99-418. The rules and regulations shall
- 27 include a requirement for a licensure application fee equal to that charged
- 28 to applicants to be licensed as a psychologist as described in Arkansas Code
- 29 § 17-97-309. Proceeds from this fee are declared as cash funds.

- 31 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 32 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 33 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
- 34 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 36 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of
the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
