22	(a) There is h	nereby created the "Arkansas Veterans	' Home Task Force".		
23	(b) The task f	force shall consist of twenty-two (22	2) members as

1	(C) The Arkansas Council of Chapters of the Military

5	(6) The Director of the Central Arkansas Veterans Healthcare		
6	System or his or her designee; and		
7	(7) The following ex officio members of the task force:		
8	(A) The Director of the Arkansas Building Authority or his		
9	or her designee;		
10	(B) The State Procurement Director or his or her designee;		
11	(C) The four (4) Arkansas members of the United States		
12	House of Representatives or their respective designees; and		
13	(D) The two (2) Arkansas members of the United States		
14	Senate or their respective designees.		
15	(c) If a vacancy occurs for any reason, the vacancy shall be filled in		
16	the same manner as the original appointment.		
17	(d) The task force shall conduct its meetings in Pulaski County at the		
18	State Capitol.		
19	(e) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall designate one (1) of		
20	the Senate members of the task force to organize the first meeting of the		
21	task force and serve as chair at the first meeting.		
22	(f)(1) By May 1, 2013, the task force shall conduct its first meeting		
23	and elect a chair from among its membership.		
24	(2) After its first meeting, the task force shall meet upon the		
25	call of the chair but shall meet at least one (1) time per month.		
26	(3) The task force shall be dissolved after making its report		
27	under subsection (i) of this section.		
28	(g)(l) A quorum is required for any action by the task force.		
29	(2) Eleven (11) members shall constitute a quorum for the		
30	purpose of transacting the business of the task force.		
31	(h)(l) The task force shall study issues related to opening a new		
32	Arkansas Veterans' Home or homes and develop specific recommendations for		
33	review, consideration, and implementation by the General Assembly.		
34	(2) Issues to be studied by the task force include without		
35	limitation:		
36	(A) A needs assessment to evaluate the:		

1	(i) Number of current and future Arkansas veterans		
2	who have a need for such a facility; and		
3	(ii) Extent of services to be offered by any		
4	Arkansas Veterans Home or homes.		
5	(B) The location or locations for facilities, to include		
6	an evaluation of:		
7	(i) Whether existing facilities are available to		
8	meet the needs identified in subdivision $(h)(2)(A)$ of this section; and		
9	(ii) Possible locations for new facilities;		
10	(C) The cost of design and construction of new facilities		
11	or of utilizing existing facilities; and		
12	(D) The manner and method of funding remodeling or new		
13	construction.		
14	(i) On or before October 31, 2013, the task force shall submit its		
15	report containing its findings and recommendations to the:		
16	(1) House Committee on Aging, Children and Youth, Legislative		
17	and Military Affairs;		
18	(2) Senate Committee on State Agencies and Governmental Affairs;		
19	<u>and</u>		
20	(3) Legislative Council.		
21	(j) The Bureau of Legislative Research shall provide staff for the		
22	task force.		
23			
24	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
25	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Arkansas veterans are not		
26	receiving the care and security to which they are entitled as a result of		
27	their valuable service to the State of Arkansas and the United States of		
28	America, and that exploration and implementation of alternatives for the care		
29	of those veterans in need of institutional and other care are of immediate		
30	concern and should be among the highest priorities of the General Assembly.		
31	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately		
32	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
33	become effective on:		
34	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
35	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
36	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		

1	bill; or
2	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
3	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
