## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY  
APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2013-2014 FISCAL  
YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established  
for the Arkansas State University for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the  
following maximum number of regular employees.

19       SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for  
20 the Arkansas State University for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, the following  
21 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
22 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two  
23 thousand sixty-four (2,064) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at  
24 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
25 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
26 classification.

28       SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
29 appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the  
30 Arkansas State University Fund, for personal services and operating expenses  
31 of the Arkansas State University for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014,

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas State University, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas State University for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, the following:

13 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 14 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 16 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
 19 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
 20 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
 21 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
 22 with in disbursement of said funds.

23

24 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 26 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 27 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
 28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
 29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
 30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
 31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

32

33 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 35 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
 36 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
2 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
3 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm  
4 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
5 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
6 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
7 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
