27	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORAL	RY LAW. FOOD		
28	SERVICE. If the University of Central Arkansas cancels the	current contract		
29	for food service and chooses to operate the food service wit	th University

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,

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SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 4 ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas may 5 make special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one 6 sport in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per fiscal 7 year for any one coach. Further, the Board of Trustees of the University of 8 Central Arkansas is hereby authorized to make additional payments to head 9 coaches at the University of Central Arkansas from revenues generated by 10 contracts with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such 11 amounts as may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the 12 coaches of consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the 13 University and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall 14 not be considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the 15 maximum salaries established for such coaches by the Act. Nothing in this 16 section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted 17 elsewhere in Arkansas statutes for the payment of allowances or bonuses to 18 coaches at the University of Central Arkansas. Further, if the special 19 allowance funds authorized herein are utilized, the University of Central 20 Arkansas shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee 21 the exact disposition of those special allowance funds. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July $1, \frac{2012}{}$

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2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

25 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 27 MEMBERSHIP AUTHORIZATION. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central 28 Arkansas is hereby authorized to enact voluntary payroll deductions for 29 employees using on-campus programs and facilities. All such deductions shall 30 be entirely voluntary in nature, shall require written authorization from 31 each participant electing to use such deductions and shall not be made on a 32 pre-tax basis. Nothing in this section shall be construed to reduce or 33 eliminate the payroll regulations established elsewhere in Arkansas Statutes. 34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2012 35 2013 through June 30, 2013 2014.

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1 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 2 REIMBURSEMENT. The Board of Trustees of the University of Central Arkansas 3 4 shall be authorized to reimburse tuition, fees, and other educational related 5 expenses of current faculty who seek additional education levels that will 6 benefit the university in meeting accreditation and professional standards. 7 Reimbursement shall be authorized only when the reimbursement request has 8 been documented by the institution to meet critical shortage instructional 9 areas. 11 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

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authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2013 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

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     effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2013 could work irreparable harm
     upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
     programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
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     being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

     and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2013.
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
