24	SECTION 1. Ark	cansas Code § 6-13-617 is amended to read as follows:
25	6-13-617. Oath	n — Term of office.
26	(a) Each direc	ctor elected or appointed shall, within ten (10) days
27	after receiving notic	ce of his or her election or appointment, subscribe to
28	the following oath:	
29	"I,	, do hereby solemnly swear or
30	affirm, that I will s	support the Constitution of the United States and the
31	Constitution of the S	State of Arkansas, and that I will not be interested,
32	directly or indirect	ly, in any contract made by the district of which I am a
33	director, except as p	permitted by state law and that I will faithfully
34	discharge the duties	as school director in

2	about to enter."		
3	(b) The county clerk, upon receipt of the oath prescribed for a		
4	director, shall immediately commission such persons, and they shall enter at		
5	once upon their duties as directors.		
6	(c) A director shall hold his or her office until a successor is		
7	elected or appointed and qualified.

9	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-618(a), concerning the organizational		
10	meeting of a school district board of directors, is amended to read as		
11	follows:		
12	(a) At the first regular meeting following the annual school election		
13	after January 1 of each year, the board of directors of each school district		
14	shall organize by electing:		
15	(1) One (1) of their number member as president;		
16	(2) One (1) of their number member as vice president; and		
17	(3) A secretary who may be, but need not be, a member of the		
18	board of directors.		
19			
20	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-14-101 is amended to read as follows:		
21	6-14-101. Applicability of general election laws.		
22	(a) The general election laws shall apply to school elections insofar		
23	as they are not in conflict with the school election laws.		
24	(b) The county board of election commissioners may include the annual		
25	school election on a separate ballot if the board determines that a separate		
26	ballot is necessary to avoid voter confusion.		
27			
28	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-14-102(a)(1), concerning the annual		
29	school election date, is amended to read as follows:		
30	(a)(1) The annual school election shall be held in each school		
31	district of the state on the third Tuesday in September Tuesday next after		
32	the first Monday in November of each year.		
33			
34	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 6-14-118 is amended to read as follows:		
35	6-14-118. Expenses.		
36	(a)(1) In $\underline{\text{special}}$ school elections, the school districts in the county		

shall reimburse the county for the cost of the election less expenses incurred for election officials at individual polling places, with each school district's share of the total being determined by multiplying the total cost of the election by a fraction, the numerator of which is the number of votes cast in the specific school election and the denominator of which is the total number of votes cast in the entire election. (2) Expenses incurred for election officials at individual polling places shall be paid by the school district in which the polling place is located. (b) At all annual or special elections, the board of directors of each school district shall pay the expenses of the election out of the school fund. /s/E. Williams
