20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-7-305(c)(1), regarding the ballot form for
21	a judicial election, is amended to read as follows:
22	(c)(l)(A) Any \underline{A} person who shall file files for any \underline{an} elective office
23	in this state may use not more than three (3) given names, one (1) of which
24	may be a nickname or any other word used for the purpose of identifying <u>to</u>
25	identify the person to the voters, and may add as a prefix to his or her name
26	the title or an abbreviation of an elective public office the person
27	currently holds.
28	(B) A person may use as the prefix the title of a
29	<u>nonpartisan</u> judicial office in an election for a judgeship <u>nonpartisan</u>
30	<u>judicial office</u> only if the :
31	<u>(i) The</u> person is currently serving in a <u>nonpartisan</u>
32	judicial position <u>office</u> to which the person has been elected <u>in the last</u>

8	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-10-103(f)(1), concerning the ballot form
9	for a judicial election, is amended to read as follows:
10	(f)(l)(A) A candidate for nonpartisan judicial office may not use more
11	than three (3) given names, one (1) of which may be a nickname or any other
12	word used for the purpose of identifying the candidate to the voters.
13	(B)(i) A candidate for nonpartisan judicial office may add
14	as a prefix to his or her name the title or an abbreviation of an elective
15	public office the candidate currently holds.
16	(ii) A candidate may use as the prefix the title of
17	a <u>nonpartisan</u> judicial office in an election for a judgeship <u>nonpartisan</u>
18	<u>judicial office</u> only if the :
19	<u>(a) The</u> candidate is currently serving in a
20	judicial position to which the candidate has been elected <u>in the last</u>
