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1	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-88-301 is amended to read as follows:
2	23-88-301. Legislative intent.
3	It is declared by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that <u>:</u>
4	(1) adequate Adequate insurance upon property in the rural areas
5	is necessary to the economic welfare of the state; and
6	(2) that while the The need for such insurance is increasing, but
7	the market for it is not adequate and may become less adequate in the
8	futur e. ;
9	(3) It is the purpose of this subchapter to provide a mandatory
10	plan to assure an adequate market for property insurance on insurable risks
11	in the rural areas of Arkansas <u>; and</u>
12	(4) To improve membership retention of homeowners and property
13	owners in a volunteer rural fire department, the responsibility to bill and
14	mail fire department renewal subscription notices for rural fire departments
15	and districts is transferred to the Arkansas Fire Training Academy.
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17	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 23-88-306(d), concerning a plan that
18	assures an adequate market for property insurance on insurable risks in the
19	rural areas of this state, is amended to read as follows:
20	(d) <u>(1)</u> The commissioner shall assess all members an amount not to
21	exceed two hundred dollars (\$200) annually , if needed, for the expense of
22	mailing fire department renewal subscription notices.
23	(2) On and after the effective date of this act, the Arkansas
24	Fire Training Academy shall be responsible for mailing fire department
25	renewal subscription notices to homeowners and property owners.
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27	SECTION 4. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>(a) On the effective date of this act, the</u>
28	Arkansas Rural Risk Underwriting Association shall transfer to the Arkansas
29	Fire Training Academy the unexpended balances collected by the association
30	under § 23-88-306(d)(1) and the property, records, and assets of the
31	association that are necessary for the academy to mail the fire department
32	renewal subscription notices as required under § 23-88-306(d)(2).
33	(b) All cash fund balances of the association transferred to the
34	academy under this section shall be used for the expense of mailing fire
35	department renewal subscription notices to homeowners and property owners.
