17	TO COMMEND THE ROLLING THUNDER NONPROFIT
18	ORGANIZATION FOR ITS CONTRIBUTIONS AND
19	ASSISTANCE TO VETERANS AND MEMBERS OF THE
20	MILITARY; AND FOR HELPING SUPPORT
21	SOLDIERS MISSING IN ACTION AND EDUCATING
22	THE PUBLIC ABOUT POW/MIA ISSUES.

25	WHEREAS, Rolling Thunder Inc., Chapter 1 Arkansas has been dedicated to
26	helping all veterans in Arkansas since 2002 and devotes its time and efforts
27	to helping our country's prisoners of war, persons missing in action,
28	veterans, military members, and their families; and
29	IMEDEAC Delline Thunder is a nonnuclit encopiaction as defined by the
30 31	WHEREAS, Rolling Thunder is a nonprofit organization as defined by the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3), incorporated in Arkansas in
32	affiliation with the National Rolling Thunder Charities organization; and
33	alliliation with the National Rolling Induder Charities Organization, and
34	WHEREAS, all donations and support received by Rolling Thunder is
35	distributed by Rolling Thunder in Arkansas; Rolling Thunder has minimal
36	overhead costs and the entire effort of each member and officer of Rolling



1	Thunder is voluntary; and
2	
3	WHEREAS, Rolling Thunder has donated hundreds of dollars and hundreds
4	of hours each year in support of military members and veterans from the State
5	of Arkansas; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, the ongoing programs of Rolling Thunder include:
8	
9	(1) Visiting with inpatient veterans several times each year
10	including on Valentine's weekend and providing a BBQ gathering each summer;
11	
12	(2) Donating money and supplies that go directly to veterans in
13	need each year to the Fort Roots VA Volunteer Services;
14	
15	(3) Visiting with and providing support and tangible items to
16	veterans at Günter's Veterans home in Vilonia, Arkansas;
17	
18	(4) Donating and distributing \$250 to each of several Arkansas
19	veterans and at-risk veteran families that are identified by the VA wounded
20	warrior coordinators at Fort Roots each year during the Christmas season and
21	as needed throughout the year;
22	
23	(5) Donating money to, assisting, and raising money for several
24	veterans organizations, including providing a van for a local veterans home
25	needing transportation and working with programs such as Toys for Tots and
26	the Wounded Warrior Program;
27	
28	(6) Providing and presenting prisoner of war and missing in
29	action flags and programs to many local communities to help educate the
30	public about the 83,000 unaccounted for soldiers missing in action from all
31	wars since World War II, including Sgt. Bowe R. Bergdahl and five other
32	soldiers in Iraq and Afghanistan; and
33	
34	(7) Assisting with the research and location of the Arkansas
35	descendants of soldiers missing in action to help Joint POW/MIA Accounting
36	Command with DNA confirmation of hundreds of unidentified remains, and

2	WHEREAS, Rolling Thunder works extensively with nationally chartered
3	veterans organizations such as Arkansas DVA, Arkansas VFW, American Legion,
4	Disabled American Veterans, and the United States Marine Corps League, and
5	with Fort Roots, Camp Robinson, the Little Rock Air Force Base, and local
6	military units,
7	
8	NOW THEREFORE,
9	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
10	STATE OF ARKANSAS:
11	
12	THAT the Senate commends and applauds the excellent work of Rolling
13	Thunder Inc. Chapter 1 Arkansas to help and support our country's veterans
14	and military members and their families, especially within the State of
15	Arkansas, and assisting with and educating the public about prisoners of war
16	and soldiers missing in action.

18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon its adoption a copy of this resolution be
19	presented to Rolling Thunder Inc. Chapter 1 Arkansas.
