COMPREHENSIVE SYSTEM OF PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT. Section 101(a)(7) of the

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- 1 Rehabilitation Act Amendments of 1992, commonly referred to as the
- 2 Comprehensive System of Personnel Development (CSPD), requires State
- 3 Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) agencies to establish qualified personnel
- 4 standards for rehabilitation personnel, including VR counselors, that are
- 5 consistent with any national or State-approved or recognized certification,
- 6 licensing, or registration that apply to a particular profession. In order to
- 7 comply with the Rehabilitation Act and its State Plan requirements, there is
- 8 hereby authorized for the Department of Career Education-Arkansas
- 9 Rehabilitation Services a general waiver of the Financial Management Guide,
- 10 R1-19-4-522 Continuing Professional Education. This waiver allows the agency
- 11 to provide college level coursework in degree programs for any eligible
- 12 employees selected by the agency. This provision covers any and all formula
- 13 and discretionary grants funded by the U.S.D.O.E. Rehabilitation Services
- 14 Administration, now or in the future, including, but not limited to, the

- 5 The amount of payment to be made directly to the counselor's student 6 loan creditor may not exceed:
 - (1) Two thousand dollars (\$2,000) per year; or
 - (2) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per employee.
- 9 The Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall pay for the
- 10 Forgiveness of Student Loan Program from the Rehabilitation Program Grants -
- 11 Grants and Aid line item authorized for the appropriation entitled
- 12 Rehabilitation Services Operations in an amount not to exceed eighty
- thousand dollars (\$80,000) per fiscal year.
- In addition, the Arkansas Rehabilitation Services agency shall provide a

8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

10	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
11	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
12	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.
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
