14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS WATERWAYS
15 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2014-
16 2015 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Waterways Commission for the 2014-2015 fiscal year, the following
24 maximum number of regular employees.

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35 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
36 to the Arkansas Waterways Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous



1 Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 2 Arkansas Waterways Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, the

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 18 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - WATERWAY DEVELOPMENT GRANT PROGRAM. There
 19 is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Waterways Commission, to be payable
 20 from the Arkansas Port, Intermodal, and Waterway Development Grant Program
 21 Fund, for grants to port authorities and intermodal authorities under the
 22 Arkansas Port, Intermodal, and Waterway Development Grant Program for port
 23 development projects as defined by Arkansas Code § 15-23-205 for the fiscal
 24 year ending June 30, 2015, the following:

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 30 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 32 ASSOCIATION DUES. Of the amounts appropriated for regional contributions by
 33 item (04) in Section 2 of this Act, three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00), or
 34 three-sevenths (3/7) whichever is less of the appropriated or funded amount,
 35 each fiscal year shall be allocated for membership dues for the Lower
 36 Mississippi Valley Flood Control Association and one thousand dollars

1 (\$1,000.00), or one-seventh (1/7) whichever is less of the appropriated or
2 funded amount, each fiscal year shall be allocated for membership dues for
3 each of the following associations: Ouachita River Valley Association, Red
4 River Valley Association, Arkansas Basin Association, and White River Valley
5 Coalition.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2012~~
7 2014 through June 30, ~~2013~~ 2015.

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9 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
30 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2014 is essential to the operation of
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2014 could work irreparable harm
35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2014.

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
