20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL
21	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

23	SECTION 1. Section 21 of the Joint Rules of the House of
24	Representatives and the Senate of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly of the
25	State of Arkansas is amended to read as follows:
26	
27	Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments
28	Section 21. The Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments shall
29	consist of the members of the Senate Committee on State Agencies and
30	Governmental Affairs and the members of the House Committee on State Agencies
31	and Governmental Affairs. No proposed constitutional amendment shall be
32	recommended to either house of the General Assembly except upon the
33	affirmative vote of a majority of the Senate members of the Joint Committee
34	on Constitutional Amendments and an affirmative vote of a majority of the
35	House members of the Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments. No
36	resolution proposing a constitutional amendment shall be filed in either the

     House of Representatives or the Senate after the thirty-first (31st) day of
 2
     each regular session of the General Assembly. All resolutions proposing
     constitutional amendments shall be referred to the Joint Committee on
 3

     Constitutional Amendments. Other resolutions proposing constitutional
 5
     amendments shall not be reported to or considered by either house of the
 6
     General Assembly until the original recommendations of the Joint Committee on
 7
     Constitutional Amendments are disposed of by both Houses. A resolution
8
     proposing a constitutional amendment may be considered only during a regular
9
     session. The Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments shall meet on the
     first (1st) Tuesday after the thirty-first (31st) day of each regular session

     of the General Assembly to establish a meeting calendar and meet regularly

     thereafter.
