## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE STABILIZATION  
9 LAW; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
10

### Subtitle

11 AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE  
12 STABILIZATION LAW OF ARKANSAS AND TO  
13 DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the Revenue  
21 Stabilization Law.  
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23 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-5-402 (a)(i) is amended to read as  
24 follows:

25 19-5-402. Maximum allocations of revenues for fiscal year 2014-2015 and  
26 thereafter.

27 (a)(i) The Treasurer of State shall first make monthly allocations in the  
28 proportions set out in this subsection to the funds and fund accounts listed  
29 below until there has been transferred a total of ~~four billion nine hundred~~  
30 ~~sixty-five million three hundred eighty thousand two hundred twenty-six~~  
31 ~~dollars (\$4,965,380,226)~~ four billion nine hundred seventy-one million five  
32 hundred eighty-seven thousand four hundred seventy-five dollars  
33 (\$4,971,587,475) or so much thereof as may become available; provided, that  
34 the Treasurer of State shall make such monthly allocations in accordance with  
35 each fund or fund account's proportionate part of the total of all such  
36 allocations set forth in this subsection:

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18           SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
19 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that funds provided by the General  
20 Assembly for the operations of the Department of Correction have, due to  
21 unforeseen circumstances, become insufficient for the department to provide  
22 essential governmental services; that this act provides additional funds that  
23 are necessary for the department to provide essential governmental services;  
24 and that a delay in this act's effective date would work irreparable harm  
25 upon the proper administration of the department and the performance of its  
26 duties. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being  
27 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and  
28 safety shall become effective on:

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(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

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(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,

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the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the  
32 bill; or

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(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is

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overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
