4	As used in this chapter:
5	(1) "Board" means the Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board; and
6	"Licensed certified social worker" means an individual who:
7	(A) Applies social work theory, knowledge, methods,
8	principles, values, and ethics, and the professional use of self to restore
9	or enhance social, psychosocial, or biopsychosocial functioning of
10	individuals, couples, families, groups, and to address needs of organizations
11	and communities;
12	(B) Practices with specialized knowledge and advanced
13	clinical skills in the areas of assessment, diagnosis, and treatment for
14	mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders and conditions;
15	(C) Conducts management, information and referral,
16	mediation, client education, supervision of employees, consultation,
17	research, advocacy, and outcome evaluation;
18	(D) May operate a private practice;
19	(E) May practice macro social work independently; and
20	(F) May engage in the activities included in the practice
21	of a licensed master social worker;
22	(2) "Licensed master social worker" means an individual who:
23	(A) Applies specialized knowledge and advanced practice
24	skills in the areas of assessment, diagnosis, treatment planning,
25	implementation and evaluation, case management, information and referral,
26	mediation, client education, counseling, advocacy, supervision of
27	nonclinical, baccalaureate-level social workers and nonlicensed master's
28	level employees, nonclinical consultation, research, community organization
29	and development, administration of social work policies, programs and
30	activities, and outcome evaluation;
31	(B) Practices social work under supervision within a
32	recognized, organized setting such as a social, medical, or governmental
33	agency;
34	(C)(i) May engage only in supervised practice as set forth
35	in rules established by the Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board;

2	(3) "Licensed social worker" means an individual who:
3	(A) Conducts a basic generalist practice that includes
4	assessment, case management, information and referral for counseling,

7	implementation, and administration of policies, programs, and activities;
8	(B) Is not qualified to diagnose and treat mental illness
9	nor to provide psychotherapy services;
10	(C) Practices only in organized settings such as social,
11	medical, or governmental agency.
12	(D)(i) Engages only in supervised practice as set forth in
13	the rules established by the board.
14	(ii) A licensed social worker shall not practice privately
15	or independently; and
16	(2)(4) "Practice of social work" means a professional service
17	which effects change in social conditions, human behavior, and emotional

19	"Social work practice" can only be performed with specialized knowledge and
20	skills related to human development, the potential for human growth, the
21	availability of social resources, and the knowledge of social systems. The
22	disciplined application of social work knowledge and skills includes, but is
23	not restricted to, the following:
24	(A) Counseling with individuals, couples, families, and
25	groups for purposes of assessment and enhancement of the problem-solving and
26	coping capacities of people; and
27	(B) The application of social work knowledge and skills in
28	social planning, administration, and research.

30	17-103-104. Exemptions.
31	(a) This chapter shall not be construed to <u>does not</u> prevent members of
