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2	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DPSAFT - OPEN ENROLLMENT PUBLIC CHARTER
3	SCHOOL CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the
4	Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and
5	Transportation, to be payable from the Open Enrollment Public Charter School
6	Capital Grant Program Fund, for the Department of Education - Division of
7	Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation the following:
8	(A) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
9	in Item (A) Section 5 of Act 231 of 2014, for grants for the repayment of
10	debt incurred by an open enrollment public charter school for academic
11	facilities or equipment, various maintenance, renovation, equipping, new
12	construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade and repair of real property
13	and facilities and purchase of instructional materials, technology systems,
14	and other academic equipment, in a sum not to exceed\$1,000,000.
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16	SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION - FEDERAL
17	FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
18	Educational Television Division, to be payable from the federal funds as
19	designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for the Department of
20	Education - Educational Television Division the following:
21	(A) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
22	in Item (B) Section 8 of Act 231 of 2014, for various maintenance,
23	renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
24	repair of real property and facilities, including grant matching, in a sum
25	not to exceed\$90,000.
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27	SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - EDUCATIONAL TELEVISION DIVISION - GENERAL
28	IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education,
29	to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
30	accounts, for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division
31	the following:
32	(A) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
33	in Item (A) Section 9 of Act 231 of 2014, for various maintenance,
34	renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
35	repair of real property and facilities, including grant matching, in a sum

not to exceed.....\$309,112.

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T	(b) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
2	in Item (B) Section 9 of Act 231 of 2014, for a transfer to the Educational
3	Television Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses for the
4	"Honoring Arkansas' War Heroes - Documenting Stories of Arkansas' World War
5	II Veterans" documentation project, in a sum not to exceed\$260,000.
6	(C) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
7	in Item (C) Section 9 of Act 231 of 2014, for construction, renovation,
8	maintenance, critical maintenance, equipment, security enhancements,
9	technology upgrades/equipment, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair
10	of real property and facilities, including grant matching, in a sum not to
11	exceed\$47,179.
12	(D) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
13	in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 45 of 2014, for costs associated with the
14	planning for a Northwest Communications Center and implementing, equipping,
15	maintenance and operating expenses of an AETN satellite broadcasting site in
16	Northwest Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed\$99,904.
17	(E) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
18	in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 45 of 2014, for costs associated with
19	implementing an AETN satellite broadcasting site in Northwest Arkansas and
20	for use by the University of Arkansas and AETN, in a sum not to exceed
21	\$89,191.
22	(F) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
23	in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 45 of 2014, for costs associated with general
24	network maintenance needed to secure the state's investment in technology and
25	to provide state matching for federal grants, in a sum not to exceed

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28	SECTION 5. REAPPROPRIATION - SCHOOL FOR THE BLIND - GENERAL
29	IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education -
30	Arkansas School for the Blind, to be payable from the General Improvement
31	Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Education
32	- Arkansas School for the Blind the following:
33	(A) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
34	in Item (A) Section 6 of Act 231 of 2014, for various maintenance,
35	renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
36	repair of real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed

1	\$1,900,000.
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3	SECTION 6. REAPPROPRIATION - SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT.
4	There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - Arkansas
5	School for the Deaf, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
6	successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department of Education - Arkansas
7	School for the Deaf the following:
8	(A) Effective July 1, 2015, the balance of the appropriation provided
9	in Item (A) Section 7 of Act 231 of 2014, for various maintenance,
10	renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and
11	repair of real property and facilities, in a sum not to exceed
12 13	\$4,600,000.
14	SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
15	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
16	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
17	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
18	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
19	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
20	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
21	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
22	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
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24	SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
25	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
26	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
27	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
28	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
29	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
30	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
31	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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33	SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
34	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
35	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
36	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2015 is essential to the operation of

_	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
3	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2015 could work irreparable harm
4	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
5	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
6	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
7	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2015.
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
