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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-4-206 is amended to read as follows:
22	3-4-206. Operation of retail liquor business near church or
23	schoolhouse prohibited.
24	(a) As used in this section, "church" means a church and all
25	immediately adjacent property owned or leased by the church that is used for
26	church purposes;
27	(a) No new permit to engage in the retail liquor business in this
28	state shall be issued by the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control
29	Division for the location of any business situated within two hundred (200)
30	yards of any church or schoolhouse.
31	(b) However, after August 13, 2001:
32	(1)(b)(l) No new permit to engage in the retail liquor business in
33	this state may be issued by the director Director of Alcoholic Beverage
34	Control Division for the location of any business situated within one
35	thousand feet (1,000') of any church or schoolhouse property line; and.
36	$\frac{(2)(A)}{(A)}$ No existing permit to engage in the retail liquor

1	business in this state may be transferred to a location within one thousand
2	feet (1,000') of any church or schoolhouse property line.
3	(B) As an exception to subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this
4	section, if any retail liquor business in this state already exists within
5	one thousand feet (1,000') of one (1) or more churches or schoolhouses, then
6	that same retail liquor store may be allowed to transfer to a new location
7	that is within one thousand feet (1,000') of the closest church or
8	schoolhouse to the present liquor store location if the new location is
9	determined by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division to serve the public
10	convenience and advantage.
11	(3) The distance specified in subdivisions (b)(1) and (2) of
12	this section shall be measured by nearest property line point to nearest
13	property line point.
14	(4) Subdivisions (b)(1) and (2) of this section apply only to an
15	application for a new permit or the transfer of an existing permit filed with
16	the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board after August 1, 2015.
