32	event of escape, and all or part of accrued good time may be taken away by					
33	the Director of the Department of Correction for infraction of rules.

35	(1) A sexual-related disciplinary violation;					
36	(2) Possession of an illegal substance or contraband; or					

1	<u>(3)</u>	Smuggling	or	trading	contraband.
