16	(a) As used in this section, "school resource officer" means a school		
17	resource officer as described under § 6-10-126.		
18	(b) A school resource officer may issue a citation to a person to		
19	appear in the local district court having jurisdiction over the place where a		
20	violation of state law occurred even if the school resource officer is		
21	outside of his or her jurisdiction if:		
22	(1) The school resource officer is accompanying students on a		
23	school-sanctioned event that takes the students outside the county in which

(B) The date and time when the recipient of the citation

(C) A cite to the specific state law that was alleged to

(D) The printed name and date of birth of the person

(E)(i) An opportunity for the person receiving the		
citation to sign the citation.		
(ii) If the person who is to receive the citation		
refuses to sign the citation, the school resource officer is required to		
arrest the person and deliver him or her to the local law enforcement agency		
having jurisdiction immediately.		
(2) The school resource officer shall file a copy of the		
citation issued under this section at least fifteen (15) days before the		
court date listed on the citation.		
(3) The school resource officer shall provide a person receiving		
a citation under this section a full and complete copy of the citation.
