7	(a) After February 1, 2008, a <u>At least sixty (60) days before the</u>	
8	application deadline, a district may request and be granted by the Division	
9	of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation a review conference	
10	that shall be held within twenty (20) working days after the date of request.	
11	(b) The district may be advised through the review conference process	
12	by an architectural and engineering firm if the school district pays the cost	
13	for the advice from the architectural and engineering firm.	
14	(c) The review conference shall consider the following:	
15	(1) That the proposed project is academic;	
16	(2) The application of the space calculation to the project	
17	agreed upon by the district and the division;	
18	(3) The wealth index of the district and the date at which the	
19	wealth index will be applied to the partnership project if approved;	
20	(4) The project cost promulgated by the Commission for Arkansas	
21	Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation under § 6-20-2509 for	
22	the project and the date on which the project cost data will be applied to	
23	the partnership project if approved; and	
24	(5) A projected amount of state funding based on current	
25	application of the wealth index and the project cost promulgated by the

28	(6) Whether or not the proposed application meets all of the	
29	technical requirements for partnership applications as set out in the
