8	HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
9	TO ENCOURAGE THE PRESIDENT, CONGRESS, AND ARKANSAS
10	CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO WORK TO RESTORE TRADE
11	RELATIONS BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND CUBA.

15	TO ENCOURAGE THE PRESIDENT, CONGRESS, AND
16	ARKANSAS CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO WORK
17	TO RESTORE TRADE RELATIONS BETWEEN THE
18	UNITED STATES AND CUBA.

21	WHEREAS, the relationship between the United States and Cuba has been
22	marked by tension, hostility, confrontation, and a fifty-plus year U.S. trade
23	embargo that remains the longest-standing embargo in modern history; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, Cuba imports more than one billion dollars worth of food every
26	year, including approximately 1.25 million tons of wheat, 500,000 tons of
27	rice, 50,000 tons of poultry, and 75,000 tons of dairy products; and
28	
29	WHEREAS, Cuba's imports are expected to grow significantly as Cuba
30	slowly recovers from the severe economic recession it has endured following
31	the withdrawal of subsidies from the former Soviet Union; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, agriculture is the largest industry in Arkansas and a leading
34	employer of Arkansans; and
35	INTEDEAC the Crate of Automood lands the United Crates in the case
36	WHEREAS, the State of Arkansas leads the United States in rice and

1	poultry production and ranks among the top ten states in production of many
2	other agriculture commodities; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, Arkansas ranks near the top ten among all states in the
5	overall value of its agricultural exports at approximately three billion
6	dollars annually; and
7	
8	WHEREAS, Arkansas is positioned to benefit from the market
9	opportunities that free trade with Cuba would provide due to our agricultural
10	abundance, transportation infrastructure, proximity to Cuba, and the consumer
11	needs of the people of Cuba; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, rather than depriving Cuba of agricultural products, the
14	United States embargo only succeeds in driving sales to competitors in other
15	countries that have no such restrictions; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, the United States' trade, financial, and travel restrictions
18	against Cuba hinder Arkansas's export of agricultural and food products and
19	the right of Arkansans to travel freely,
20	
21	NOW THEREFORE,
22	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL
23	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
24	
25	THAT the President and the Congress of the United States consider the
26	removal of trade, financial, and travel restrictions relating to Cuba and
27	work to restore trade relations between the United States and Cuba.
28	
29	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives
30	provide copies of this resolution to the President of the United States, to
31	the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United States, to the
32	President of the Senate of the United States, and to all members of the
33	Arkansas delegation to the Congress with the request that this resolution be
34	officially entered into the Congressional Record.
