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26	SECTION 1. Ar	kansas Code § 6-53-103 is amended to re	ead as follows:

29	(1) "Br	anch campus of the community college" i	means an
30	institution with facilities located apart from the community college campus		
31	but within the community college district;

1 (iii) The initial purchase of library holdings, furniture, apparatuses, and other equipment for a new or expanded facility as 2 defined by the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board. 3 4 (B) "Capital outlay expense" excludes those expenses used 5 for maintenance and replacement of equipment and furniture; 6 (3) "Community college" means an institution of higher education 7 established or to be established under the provisions of this chapter 8 dedicated primarily to the educational needs of the service area and offering 9 a comprehensive program, including, but without limitation, vocational, 10 trade, and technical specialty courses and programs, college transfer 11 courses, and courses in general adult education; 12 (4) "Department" means the Department of Higher Education; 13 (5) "District" means the geographic area located within one (1) 14 or more counties or cities or any described combination thereof or any 15 described area which that may be in one (1) or more counties or parts of 16 counties but within the same service area which boundary that is directly 17 responsible for the local financial support and local administration of an 18 institution located within its service area; 19 (6)(5) "Existing community college" means a community college 20 established in accordance with the provisions of and presently operating in 21 conformity with Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 52, and §§ 6-61-101 - 6-61-22 103, 6-61-201 - 6-61-209, 6-61-212 - 6-61-216, 6-61-301 - 6-61-305, 6-61-401, 23 6-61-402, 6-61-501 - 6-61-524, and 6-61-601 - 6-61-603; 24 (7)(6) "Local board" means the governing body of a technical 25 college or community college; 26 (8)(A)(7)(A) "Operating expense" means those educational and 27 general funds devoted to or required for the regular or ordinary expense of the college, including administrative, maintenance, and salary expenses but 28 29 excluding capital outlay expenses, student activity expenses, and expenses 30 for intercollegiate athletics. 31 (B) "Operating expense" includes maintenance and 32 replacement of furniture and equipment, including motor vehicles; 33 (9) (8) "Satellite campus" means an institution or off-campus 34 facility of a community college located within a service area of a technical 35 or community college but not located within a community college district; 36 (10)(A) "Service area" means the geographic area assigned by the

10	education established under this chapter <del>dedicated primarily to the</del>

14	comparable in content and quality to freshman and sophomore courses $\frac{1}{2}$

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18	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-53-203(a)(2), concerning the duties and		
19	powers of the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, is repealed.		
20	(2) To determine service areas containing all counties within		
21	the state and to recommend adoption of such service areas to the full board,		
22	who shall designate which system institution within the service area shall be		
23	responsible for fulfillment of the two year postsecondary educational needs		
24	of the service area;		
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26	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-53-301(e), concerning the Arkansas		
27	Technical and Community College System, is amended to read as follows:		
28	(e) The local board shall be responsible for the administration and		
29	operation of the institution and shall be further responsible for the		
30	provision of services to meet the two-year postsecondary educational needs of		
31	those citizens located within the service area of the institution state.		
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33	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-53-302(c), concerning local		
34	administration, is amended to read as follows:		
35	(c) Members of the local board shall be qualified electors of the		

Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board as the area to be served by the

service area district of the technical college and knowledgeable in business,

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l labor, industry, or economic development.

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- 3 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code §§ 6-53-304-6-53-306 are amended to read as 4 follows:
- 5 6-53-304. Student tuition Fees.
- 6 (a) The intent of this chapter is to make technical and community
  7 college programs available to as many citizens of Arkansas as possible. To
  8 this end, tuition and fees should be maintained at a reasonable level so as
  9 not to exclude citizens because of cost.
- 10 (b) The local board shall determine the minimum student tuition and 11 fees to be charged by institutions within the system.
  - (c) The local board shall set both in-district and out-of-district student tuition and fees for each institution within its service area district. Students residing outside a community college district may be subject to extra tuition and fees.

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- 17 6-53-305. Transportation.
  - A technical or community college may establish and operate a transportation system for students within the <u>service area district</u> of the institution assigned by the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board.

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- 22 6-53-306. Coordination with secondary vocational-technical education 23 and literacy programs.
  - Upon the approval of the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, the local board may contract with the Department of Career Education, a nonprofit organization, or a local school district board of directors within its service area to offer secondary-level vocational and technical courses and programs, adult literacy courses, and industry training.

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- 30 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 6-53-402(b)-(e), concerning two-year 31 branches, is amended to read as follows:
- 32 (b) Upon approval by the board and the Higher Learning Commission and upon assignment of a service area for the institution, the two-year branch 34 campus shall be known as a technical college.
  - (c) All records, personnel, property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds of the two-year branch campus

- 1 shall be transferred to the board until a local board is appointed.
- 2 (d) Upon the appointment of a local board, all records, personnel, 3 property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds 4 of the technical college shall be transferred to the local board.
  - (e) The local board shall be responsible for the administration and operation of the technical college and such other state-supported institutions within the system located in the service area designated by the state board as necessary to adequately meet the two-year postsecondary educational needs of those citizens located within the service area assigned to the technical college.

- SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 6-53-403(b), concerning technical colleges and two-year branches, is amended to read as follows:
  - (b) Prior to the election, the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall assist any group of citizens representing a proposed community college district within the service area containing the technical college in determining the feasibility of the proposed district and the adequacy of the proposed millage levy, if any.

- SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 6-53-404(a)-(c), concerning technical colleges, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) A board of trustees of a community college may, by resolution or when requested, petition the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board to accept a technical college <del>located in the same service area</del> to be a branch campus of the community college.
- (b) All records, personnel, property, unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds of above-listed state-supported institutions within the service area of the community college shall be transferred to the local board.
- 30 (c) The local board of the community college shall be <u>is</u> responsible 31 for the administration and operation of all state-supported postsecondary 32 vocational-technical institutions <del>located within its service area and</del> 33 consolidated by this chapter.
