11	which the loans are made. The loans shall be repaid prior to before the end		
12	of the fiscal year. After the loans have been repaid, the Prevention and		
13	Cessation Program Account shall be transferred the difference between thirty-		
14	one and six-tenths percent (31.6%) twenty-seven and two-tenths percent		
15	(27.2%) of amounts received in the Tobacco Settlement Program Fund during the		
16	fiscal year in which the loans are made and the amount of the loans.

18	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
19	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Medicaid Expansion Progra		
20	Account currently funds a program that provides increased healthcare access		
21	to Arkansans; that this increased healthcare access is necessary for the		
22	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; that increased funding		
23	is essential to continuation of that program; and that without this increased		
24	funding, the program may be compromised. Therefore, an emergency is declared		
25	to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public		
26	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2015.
