21	SECTION 1. Ar	kansas Code Title 14, Chapter 229, Subc	hapter l, is
22	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

25	<u>(a)(l) A wate</u>	r provider in this state shall provide	services to a
26	nonresident property	owner or consumer whose property lies	within the water
27	provider-accepted se	rvice area if requested by the nonresid	ent property owner
28	or consumer, except	as provided under this section.	
29	<u>(2) A w</u>	ater provider shall supply the same amo	unt of water and
30	water pressure to re	sident property owners or consumers and	nonresident
31	property owners or c	onsumers if infrastructure exists to do	so, but a water
32	provider is not obli	gated to increase the number or size of	, or change the
33	location of, mains o	r pipes outside its boundaries.	
34	(3)(A)	Water shall be supplied to resident pro	perty owners or

1	(B)(i) A water provider may establish separate rate		
2	classifications for resident property owners or consumers and nonresident		
3	property owners or consumers with reasonable justification.		
4	(ii) The water provider shall treat all property		
5	owners or consumers within a rate classification equally.		
6	(b)(l) A water provider shall provide services to a nonresident		
7	property owner or consumer at the request of the nonresident property owner		
8	or consumer if:		
9	(A) The nonresident property owner or consumer does not		
10	have access to any other water service;		
11	(B) The nonresident property owner or consumer resides in		
12	a water improvement district that:		
13	(i) Has installed water lines or other		
14	infrastructure; and		
15	(ii) Has deeded the infrastructure to the water		
16	provider, and the water provider has accepted the infrastructure with no		
17	requirement for annexation;		
18	(C) Infrastructure to supply services exists at the time		
19	of the request; and		
20	(D) The nonresident property owner or consumer provides		
21	any necessary pipes or structures to access the water provider		
22	infrastructure.		
23	(2) Resident property owners or consumers and nonresident		
24	property owners or consumers who seek water or receive water service for		
25	agricultural, developmental, or industrial purposes shall be treated equally		
26	in relation to any water conservation measures.		
27	(c) Except for emergency measures established by rule and promulgated		
28	by the Department of Health, a water provider shall treat all property owners		
29	and consumers equally in terms of service, including without limitation:		
30	(1) The provision of water; and		
31	(2) The availability of new service.
