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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-441(a) and (b), concerning the	
23	Arkansas College and Career Readiness Planning Program, are amended t	o read
24	as follows:	
25	(a) As used in this section:	
26	(1) "College and career readiness" means the acquisition	of the
27	knowledge and skills a student needs to be successful in future endea	vors,
28	including:	
29	(A) Successfully completing credit-bearing, first-y	ear
30	courses at a postsecondary institution; and	
31	(B) Embarking on a chosen career; <u>and</u>	
32	(2) "College and career readiness assessment" means a tes	t that
33	measures student readiness for postsecondary learning and is:	
34	(A) Administered under this section; or	-
35	(B) Used by an institution of higher education as p	art of
36	its admissions, placement, and scholarship processes;	

1	(3) "EXPLORE" means the pre-ACT assessment designed by ACT, Inc.	
2	help students in grade eight (8) explore a broad range of options for	
3	their future and focus not only on high school coursework but also on post-	
4	high school choices;	
5	(4) "PLAN" means the pre-ACT assessment for students in grade ten	
6	(10) used to help a student focus attention on improved academic achievement,	
7	career preparation, and planning for post-high school years; and	
8	(5) "PSAT" means the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship	
9	Qualifying Test that provides practice for the SAT Reasoning Test and gives	
10	students feedback on individual strengths and weaknesses on college readiness	
11	skills.	
12	(b)(l)(A) A public school that serves students in grade eight (8) shall	
13	administer <b>EXPLORE</b> a college and career readiness assessment approved by the	
14	State Board of Education to each student enrolled in grade eight (8) at the	
15	public school.	
16	(B) A public school that serves students in grade grades	
17	ten <del>(10)</del> through twelve (10-12) shall administer <del>PLAN or the PSAT</del> <u>a college</u>	
18	and career readiness assessment approved by the state board to each student	
19	enrolled in grade ten (10) at the public school before the student graduates	
20	from high school.	
21	(2) Funding for the college and career readiness assessments	
22	listed in subdivision (b)(1) of this section may be paid by using Department	
23	of Education at-risk funding.	
24	(3)(A) The department may designate alternative assessments other	
25	than EXPLORE, PLAN, or PSAT to satisfy the purposes of this section.	
26	(B) The alternative assessments may include without	
27	limitation next-generation assessments as approved by the State Board of	
28	Education.	
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
