- 34 action committee and no expenditure shall be made by a political action
- 35 committee that has not registered and does not have a resident agent.
- 36 (C) It shall be unlawful for a prohibited political action

12	political parties, county political party committees, or other political		
13	action committees within this state.		
14	(B) Subdivision (a)(4)(A) of this section shall not apply		
15	to:		
16	(i) The national committee of any political party		
17	that is registered with the Federal Election Commission;		
18	(ii) Any federal candidate committee that is		
19	registered with the Federal Election Commission;		
20	(iii) Funds which a subordinate committee of the		
21	national committee of any political party that is registered with the Federa		
22	Election Commission transfers to the federal account of an organized		
23	political party as defined under § 7-1-101; or		
24	(iv) Funds which a political action committee that		
25	is registered with the Federal Election Commission transfers to the federal		
26	account of an organized political party as defined under § 7-1-101.		
27	(b) The registration form of an approved political action committee		
28	shall contain the following information:		
29	(1) The name, address, and, where available, phone number of the		
30	political action committee and the name, address, phone number, and place of		
31	employment of each of its officers, provided if the political action		
32	committee's name is an acronym, then both it and the words forming the		
33	acronym shall be disclosed;		
34	(2) The professional, business, trade, labor, or other interests		
35	represented by the political action committee, including any individual		
36	business, organization, association, corporation, labor organization, or		

- l other group or firm whose interests will be represented by the political

- 3 (3) The full name and street address, city, state, and zip code
- 4 of each financial institution the political action committee uses for

- 17 (c)(1) When a committee makes a change to any information required in
- 18 subsection (b) of this section, an amendment shall be filed within ten (10)
- 19 days to reflect the change.
- 20 (2) A committee failing to file an amendment shall be subject to
- 21 a late filing fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each day the change is not
- 22 filed.
- 23 (d)(1) Within fifteen (15) calendar days after the end of each
- 24 calendar quarter, a political action committee shall file a quarterly report
- 25 with the Secretary of State, including the following information:
- 26 (A) The total amount of contributions received and the
- 27 total amount of contributions made during the filing period and the
- 28 cumulative amount of those totals;
- 29 (B) The current balance of political action committee
- 30 funds;
- 31 (C) The name and address of each person that made a
- 32 contribution or contributions to the political action committee that exceeded
- 33 five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate during the calendar year, the
- 34 contributor's place of business, employer, occupation, the date of the
- 35 contribution, the amount contributed, and the total contributed for the year;
- 36 (D) The name and address of each candidate, ballot

- l question committee, legislative question committee, political party, county
- 2 political party committee, or other political action committee, if any, to
- 3 whom or which the political action committee made a contribution or
- 4 contributions that exceeded fifty dollars (\$50.00) in the aggregate during
- 5 the filing period, with the amount contributed and the election for which the
- 6 contribution was made;
- 7 (E) The name and address of each candidate, ballot
- 8 question committee, legislative question committee, political party, county
- 9 political party committee, or other political action committee, if any, to
- 10 whom or which the political action committee contributed a nonmonetary item,
- 11 together with a description of the item, the date the item was contributed,
- 12 and the value of the item; and
- 13 (F) The total amount of expenditures made for
- 14 administrative expenses and for each single expenditure that exceeded one
- 15 hundred dollars (\$100), an itemization including the amount of the
- 16 expenditure, the name and address of the person to whom the expenditure was
- 17 made, and the date the expenditure was made.
- 18 (2) Political action committee quarterly reports may be filed in
- 19 <u>electronic form through the official website of the Secretary of State if</u>
- 20 <u>electronic filing is offered by the Secretary of State.</u>
- 21 $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$ The information required in subdivision (d)(1)(C)-(F) of
- 22 this section may be provided in the form of schedules attached to $\frac{1}{1}$
- 23 report filed in paper form.
- 24 (3)(4) The reports shall be verified by an affidavit of an
- 25 officer of the political action committee stating that to the best of his or
- 26 her knowledge and belief the information so disclosed is a complete, true,
- 27 and accurate financial statement of the political action committee's
- 28 contributions received and made.
- 29 $\frac{(4)(A)(5)(A)}{(4)(4)(4)}$ A report is timely filed if it is:
- 30 <u>(i)</u> either delivered <u>Delivered</u> by hand or mailed to
- 31 the Secretary of State, properly addressed, postage prepaid, and bearing a
- 32 postmark indicating that it was received by the post office or common carrier
- 33 on or before the date that the report is due if the report is filed in paper
- 34 form; or
- 35 <u>(ii) Filed in electronic form through the official</u>
- 36 <u>website of the Secretary of State on or before</u> the date that the report is

1	due if the Secretary of State offers electronic filing of political action	
2	committee reports.	
3	(B) The Secretary of State shall accept via facsimile any	
4	report <u>filed in paper form</u> if the original is received by the Secretary of	
5	State within ten (10) days of the date of transmission.	
6	(C) The Secretary of State may receive reports in a	
7	readable electronic format that is acceptable to the Secretary of State and	
8	approved by the Arkansas Ethics Commission.	
9	(D) If the Secretary of State chooses to offer electronic	
10	filing of political action committee reports:	
11	(i) The Arkansas Ethics Commission shall approve a	
12	format used by the Secretary of State for the filing of political action	
13	committee reports in electronic form under this section to ensure that all	
14	required information is requested; and	
15	(ii) The official website of the Secretary of State	
16	shall allow for searches of political action committee report information	
17	filed in electronic form.	
18	(6)(A) A political action committee shall indicate on its	
19	quarterly report for the fourth quarter of each calendar year whether or not	
20	it intends to renew its registration for the next calendar year.	
21	(B)(i) If a fourth quarter report is filed in paper form,	
22	the form utilized by the Secretary of State for filing shall require the	
23	political action committee to indicate whether or not it intends to renew its	
24	registration for the next calendar year.	
25	(ii) A political action committee indicating that it	
26	will renew its registration for the next calendar year shall submit its	
27	registration form for the next calendar year at the same time as the	
28	quarterly report for the fourth quarter.	
29	(iii) The Secretary of State shall not accept a	
30	quarterly report for the fourth quarter if:	
31	(a) The political action committee indicates	
32	that it intends to renew its registration for the next calendar year; and	
33	(b) The registration form for the next	
34	calendar year is not submitted at the same time as the quarterly report for	
35	the fourth quarter.	
36	(C) If the Secretary of State offers electronic filing of	

1	political action committee reports, the format used by the Secretary of State
2	for the filing of political action committee reports in electronic form shall
3	require a political action committee indicating that it intends to renew its
4	registration for the next calendar year to renew its registration for the
5	next calendar year before submitting its quarterly report for the fourth
6	quarter.
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
