27	has been assessed as a Level 3 or Level 4 offender to know	vingly enter upon

29	(c) It is not a violation of this section if the se	ex offender:
30	(1) Is less than twenty-two (22) years of age	e and is a student
31	enrolled in a grade kindergarten through twelve (K-12) pro	ogram;
32	(2) Enters upon the campus for the purpose of	attending a

8	(B) Attending a scheduled parent-teacher conference if the
