If there is not sufficient appropriation, 2 from funds deposited in the State Treasury or Cash Accounts of an agency, for personal services, or personal services matching for any state agency for the 3 4 period ending June 30, 2016 2017, for State agencies that process payroll 5 through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for federal 6 and state tax reporting as necessary to comply with the payment of stipends 7 under United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 3401 and 8 Treasury Regulations §31.3401(c)-1(a) and §1.1402(c)-2(b), and others which 9 govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes 10 for personal services, the agency shall request a transfer from appropriation 11 provided for Personal Services and Personal Services Matching in the 12 appropriation for Various State Agencies - U.S. IRC and Treasury Regulations 13 herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, stating clearly the 14 amounts required for each item. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of 15 the State, the State Auditor shall be notified as to the amount and the 16 purposes for which the appropriation is to be made and such appropriation as 17 needed shall be established upon the books of the Department of Finance and 18 Administration and the State Auditor. Provided, however, that in the event 19 the total amount of transfer requested in any fiscal year exceeds Ten 20 Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall seek 21 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 22 before the transfer shall be made.

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26 SECTION 74. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITION ESTABLISHMENT. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall have the authority 28 29 to establish such positions as necessary for State agencies to process payroll through the Arkansas Administrative Statewide Information System for 30 31 federal and state tax reporting purposes as necessary to comply with the 32 United States Internal Revenue Code (IRC), 2001-Code-Vol, Sec 3401 and 33 Treasury Regulations §31.3401(c)-1(a) and §1.1402(c)-2(b), and others which 34 govern the reporting of income and payment of withholding and matching taxes 35 for personal services. The positions established shall not be considered as 36 part of the total number of authorized positions for an agency and shall only

be considered as placeholders for payments to individuals who are board or commission members or elected officials of the State that do not otherwise receive salaries or wages as defined in §19-4-521 for their personal services. Further, none of the positions established under this section shall imply eligibility for state retirement or state health insurance benefits. The establishment of such positions shall not exceed 250 positions in any fiscal year.

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11 SECTION 75. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER AUTHORIZED - BURN CENTER. The Arkansas Children's Hospital may request the 13 14 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer the sum of not to exceed 15 \$1,000,000 each fiscal year from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account from 16 funds made available by this Act for the Arkansas Children's Hospital Burn 17 Center to the Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account. The 18 transferred funds shall be used to match federal funds used for supplemental 19 Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's Hospital.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
21 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

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23 SECTION 76. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 25 INNOVATION AND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT FUND TRANSFERS. The Department of 26 Information Systems is a cost recovery agency subject to the requirements of 27 the United States Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87 Cost 28 Principles for State, Local and Indian Tribal Government (A-87) and Cost 29 Principles for Developing Cost Allocation Plans and Indirect Cost Rates for Agreements with the Federal Government Implementation Guide for the Office of 30 31 Management and Budget Circular A-87 (ASMBC-10). To comply with these federal 32 rules, it is necessary to establish an Innovation and Project Development 33 appropriation and general revenue fund account within the Department of 34 Finance and Administration Disbursing Officer for the Department of 35 Information Systems. This fund shall be used for state enterprise innovation 36 projects that would enhance the technology operations of the State that

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cannot be cost allocated to federal programs. The Department of Information
 Systems will maintain documentation for projects billed for these purposes.
 Fund transfers may be made from the General Revenue Fund Account, upon the
 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review of the
 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to reimburse the
 Department of Information Systems for the amounts billed.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015

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SECTION 77. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK 12 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have 13 14 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-15 205(d)(2)(B), such documents as may be necessary shall be processed so that 16 funds may be transferred from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the 17 State Treasury fund or fund account from which the technical institute or 18 comprehensive lifelong learning center draws its general revenue support. 19 Such funds as may be transferred shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds 20 available from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund during each fiscal year. 21 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational 22 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund 23 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies 24 25 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force 26 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational 27 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of 28 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

29 The funds distributed under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of 30 those amounts collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall be 31 deposited into the Skills Development Fund to be used only for personal 32 services, grants, operation, support, and improvement of occupational, 33 vocational, technical, and workforce development programs by the Department of Career Education - Office of Skills Development. The distributions of 34 funds under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of those amounts 35 36 collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall not apply to proceeds

allocated to schools, colleges and educational institutions under Arkansas
 Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-205(d)(2)(B).

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6 SECTION 78. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 8 PROCEDURES - EXTRA HELP. In the event that there is not sufficient 9 appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for payment of Extra Help 10 for any state agency for the period ending June 30, 2016 2017, said agency 11 may request a transfer from appropriations provided for Extra Help in Section 12 2, Miscellaneous Transfers, herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 13 State, stating clearly the amount required. Upon approval of the Chief 14 Fiscal Officer of the State, and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas 15 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be 16 notified as to the amount and the purposes for which said appropriation is to 17 The appropriation shall then be established upon the books of the be made. 18 Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided 19 further, that if desired, said appropriation shall be supplemental to those 20 regularly appropriated for such purposes by the General Assembly for the 21 agency.

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25 SECTION 79. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTRASTATE 27 METRO PLANNING GRANTS. As referenced in Section 9 of Act 637 of 1995, the 28 authorized funding for Intrastate Metro Planning Grants that are evenly 29 distributed among planning and development districts under Section 3 of this act shall include the West Central Arkansas Economic Development District. 30 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 32 through June 30, 2017.

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SECTION 80. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
 USAGE AUTHORIZED. The Arkansas Children's Hospital President and C.E.O. may

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request the Department of Human Services-Division of Medical Services to retain in the Department of Human Services Grant Fund account an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 for funds made available by the act to be used to match federal funds used for supplemental Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's

5 Hospital.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
7 <u>2016</u> through June 30, 2016 <u>2017</u>.

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9 SECTION 81. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 10 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 12 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 13 14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 82. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 21 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 22 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 27

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SECTION 83. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 29 30 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of 31 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 33 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm 35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 36 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
